GENERAL PROVISIONS

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Chapter 1.01

CODE

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1.01.010 Adopted. Pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.0103, there is hereby adopted and recreated the “Wausau Municipal Code,” which code is incorporated herein by reference, and which code is available for inspection in the city clerk’s office; this code supercedes and replaces all previously adopted codes, which codes are hereby deleted. (Ord. 61-5168 §1, 2002, File No. 02-0310; Ord. 61-4113 §1, 1968.)

1.01.020 Title—Citation—Reference. This code shall be known as the Wausau Municipal Code and it shall be sufficient to refer to this code as the Wausau Municipal Code in any prosecution for the violation of any provision thereof or in any proceeding at law or equity. It shall also be sufficient to designate any ordinance adding to, amending, correcting or repealing all or any part or portion thereof as an addition to, amendment to, correction of, or repeal of the Wausau Municipal Code. Further reference may be had to the titles, chapters, sections and subsections of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wausau Municipal Code and such reference shall apply to that numbered title, chapter, section or subsection as it appears in this code. 1.01.025 Issuance of citations. (a) Authority. Pursuant to the authority of Section 66.0113 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, the city elects to adopt and authorize the use of a citation to be issued for violations of ordinances, including ordinances for which a statutory counterpart exists.

(b) Citation. The form of the citation is prescribed as found in Section 66.0113(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, which is incorporated herein by reference.

(c) Schedule of cash deposits.

(1) A schedule of cash deposits is established as follows:

(A) The Revised Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule and Alcohol Beverages, Harassment, Safety, Tobacco, U.W. Rule, and Drug Paraphernalia Violations Deposit Schedule and Uniform Misdemeanor Bail Schedule and Trespass to Land Deposit Schedule as revised and amended and including any amendments and/or revisions thereto is herein adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

(B) For violations of all ordinances other than those governed by the aforescribed Uniform State Deposit Schedule and except as provided in subsection (C), the cash deposit schedule shall be as follows:

(C) For violations of ordinances contained in Chapters 15 and 16 of this code other than as specifically set forth in subsection (c)(1)(B) above, and for all ordinances other than those aforescribed, the cash deposit schedule shall be \$100.

(2) In addition to the appropriate cash deposit amount as established above, all citations issued under this ordinance shall further specify and include as part of the deposit any penalty surcharge that would be applicable under Section 757.05 of the Wisconsin Statutes, any jail surcharge that would be applicable under Section

302.46(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, any crime labs and drug law enforcement surcharge that would be applicable under Section 165.755 of the Wisconsin Statutes, any consumer protection surcharge that would be applicable under Section 100.261 of the Wisconsin Statutes, any domestic abuse assessments that would be applicable under Section 973.055(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and maximum court costs imposed by Section 814.65 of the Wisconsin Statutes. In the event that the state of Wisconsin amends Section 814.65 of the Wisconsin Statutes, this subsection shall be automatically amended and the maximum amount allowed by the state shall take effect upon passage of the state's amendment, without further action by the common council.

(3) Cash deposits shall be made to the appropriate court clerk or to the appropriate individual in the finance department, treasurer division, and receipts shall be given for deposits.

d) The fact that a defendant has posted the property monetary bond for the offense does not and shall not prohibit the judge from ordering the defendant into court when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the city or to protect the basic rights of the defendant. 1.01.027 Providing inspectors with the ability to issue citations. The director of inspections and electrical systems, the building inspector, the plumbing inspector, the electrical inspector, the property inspector, the director of public works, the fire chief, and the police chief, and any employee within the table of organization of the department of public works specifically delegated with this citation authority by the director of public works, and any employee within the table of organization of the fire department specifically delegated with this citation authority by the fire chief, and any employee within the table of organization of the police department specifically delegated with this citation authority by the police chief, are given the authority, pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.0113 of the Wisconsin Statutes, to issue citations for violations of ordinances directly relating to their official responsibilities. 1.01.030 Reference applies to amendments. Whenever a reference is made to this code as the Wausau Municipal Code or to any portion thereof, or to any ordinance of the city, the reference

shall apply to all amendments, corrections and additions heretofore, now, or hereafter made. (Ord. 61-4113 §3, 1968.)

1.01.040 Codification authority. This code consists of all of the regulatory and penal ordinances and certain of the administrative ordinances of the city, codified pursuant to Section 66.0103 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (Ord. 61-4113 §4, 1968.)

1.01.050 Definitions. The following words and phrases whenever used in this code shall be construed as defined in this section unless from the context a different meaning is intended, or unless a different meaning is specifically defined and more particularly directed to the use of such words or phrases:

- (a) "City" means the city of Wausau, Wisconsin, and such territory outside of this city over which the city has jurisdiction or control by virtue of any constitutional provisions, or any law;
- (b) "Common council" means the common council of the city;
- (c) "Mayor" means the mayor of the city;
- (d) "County" means the county of Marathon;
- (e) "Fiscal year." The calendar year shall be the fiscal year;
- (f) "Person" means any natural person, firm, association, joint venture, joint stock company, partnership, organization, club, company, corporation, business trust, or its manager, lessee, agent, servant, officer, or employee or any of them;
- (g) "Oath" includes affirmative;
- (i) "Office." The use of the title of any officer, employee, or any office, or ordinance shall mean such officer, employee, office, ordinance of the city, unless otherwise specifically designated;
- (j) "State" means the state of Wisconsin;
- (k) "Shall" and "must." Each is mandatory;
- (l) "May" is permissive;
- (m) "Written" includes printed, typewritten, mimeographed or multigraphed. (Ord. 41-4113 §5, 1968.)

1.01.060 Grammatical interpretation. The following grammatical rules shall apply in this code:

- (a) Gender. Any gender includes the other genders;

(b) Singular and plural. The singular number includes the plural and the plural includes the singular;

(c) Tenses. Words used in the present tense include the past and the future tenses and vice versa;

(d) Use of words and phrases. Words and phrases used in this code and not specifically defined shall be construed according to the context and approved usage of the language. (Ord. 61-4113 §6, 1968.)

1.01.070 Construction. The provisions of this code and all proceedings under it are to be construed with a view to effect its objects and to promote justice. (Ord. 61-4113 §7, 1968.)

1.01.080 Title, chapter and section headings. Title, chapter and section headings contained herein shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of any title, chapter or section hereof. (Ord. 61-4113 §8, 1968.)

1.01.090 Reference to specific ordinances. The provisions of this code shall not in any manner affect deposits or other matters of record which refer to, or are otherwise connected with ordinances which are therein specifically designated by number or otherwise and which are included within this code, but such reference shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this code. (Ord. 61-4113 §9, 1968.)

1.01.100 Effect on past actions and obligations. Neither the adoption of this code nor the repeal or amendments hereby of any ordinance or part or portion of any ordinance of the city shall in any manner affect the prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date hereof, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty at said effective date due and unpaid under such ordinances, nor be construed as affecting any of the provisions of such ordinances relating to the collection of any such licenses, fee, or penalty, or the penal provisions applicable to any violation thereof, nor to affect the validity of any bond or cash deposit in lieu thereof required to be posted, filed, or deposited pursuant to any ordinance, and all rights and obligations thereunder appertaining shall continue in full force and effect. 1.01.110 Penalty where no penalty provided. (a) In any case where there is a violation of any city ordinance for which no penalty is provided, the person violating the same shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than ten dollars nor more than two hundred dollars for each offense, except as provided in the following subsection.

(b) In any case where any ordinance or section of an ordinance of the city shall not provide the greater penalty for a second or subsequent conviction for a violation thereof any person violating the same who has previously been convicted of a violation thereof shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars for each offense, except that where the penalty provided by any such ordinance or section for a first violation thereof is larger than the penalty herein provided such larger penalty shall be applicable.

(c) No violation of any ordinance of the city shall be, or be construed to be, a misdemeanor nor shall imprisonment be imposed as a punishment for violation of any ordinance of the city except in the event of a failure of the defendant to pay the forfeiture imposed by the court, any other provision of the general ordinances of the city to the contrary notwithstanding.

(d) Each such person who violates any city ordinance is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any regulatory provision of the ordinances of Wausau is committed, continued or permitted by any such person, and he shall be punished accordingly. 1.01.120 Repeal. All general ordinances of the city not included in this code or excluded from the operation effect of this section are hereby repealed. (Ord. 61-4113 §11, 1968.)

1.01.130 Repeal shall not revive any ordinances. The repeal of an ordinance shall not repeal the repealing clause of such ordinance or revive any ordinance which has been repealed thereby. (Ord. 61-4113 §12, 1968.)

1.01.140 Exclusions. Every special ordinance of this city governing the following subject matter, whether contained in whole or in part within this code, is excluded from the operation and effect of section 1.01.120 and is not affected by the repeal provisions hereof: Annexations; franchises; naming road, streets and public places; acquisitions or disposal of public property; vacation of streets, alleys or public ways; acceptance of any gift, device, license or other benefit; provided that the foregoing enumeration of exceptions or exclusions are not deemed to be exclusive or exhaustive, it being the intent and purpose to exclude from repeal any and all ordinances not of a general nature. (Ord. 61-4113 §13, 1968.)

1.01.150 Effective date. This code shall become effective on the date Ordinance 61-4113 adopting this code as the Wausau Municipal Code shall become effective. (Ord. 61-4113 §14, 1968.)

1.01.160 Prohibited acts include causing and permitting. Whenever in this code any act or omission is made unlawful, it includes causing, allowing, permitting, aiding, abetting, suffering, or concealing the fact of such act or omission. (Ord. 61-4113 §15, 1968.)

1.01.170 Constitutionality. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this code is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this code. The common council hereby declares that it would have passed this code, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases had been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if for any reason this code should be declared invalid or unconstitutional then the original ordinance or ordinances shall be in full force and effect. 1.04.010 Clerk to file. Whenever in this code any standard, code, rule, regulation or other written or printed matter, other than the Wisconsin Statutes or other sections of this code, are adopted by reference, they shall be deemed incorporated in this code as if fully set forth herein and the clerk is hereby directed and required to file, deposit and keep in his office a copy of the code, standard, rule, regulation or other written or printed matter as adopted. Materials so filed, deposited and kept shall be public records open for examination with proper care by any person during the clerk's office hours, subject to such orders or regulations which the clerk may prescribe for their preservation. 1.08.010 Wards and polling places. The polling place for each ward shall be established from time to time by resolution of the common council in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.25 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (Ord. 61-4754 §1(part), 1991.)

1.08.020 Hours for voting. The polls in the city at any general election, primary election, local election or special election shall be open from seven a.m. to eight p.m., pursuant to the provisions of Section 6.78 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (Ord. 61-4754 §1(part), 1991.)

1.08.030 Election officers. There shall be at least five election officials at each polling place. These officials shall be qualified and appointed pursuant to the provisions of Sections 7.30 to 7.53 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (Ord. 61-5127 §1, 2001, File No. 01-0725; Ord. 61-4754 §1(part), 1991.)

1.08.040 Primary. Pursuant to Sections 8.11(1)(b) and 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes, it is provided that whenever three or more candidates file nomination papers for a city office, a primary election shall be held for the nomination of candidates for such office. Such primary shall be held as provided in Chapters 5 through 12 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (Ord. 61-4755 §1, 1991; prior code §1.04.)

1.08.050 Board of canvassers. There shall be a board of canvassers, such board to consist of three members and an alternate, the clerk being a permanent member and the two remaining members and the alternate to be made up of qualified electors of the municipality designated by the clerk within a reasonable period of time prior to the date upon which an election is to be held.
