**BID OPENING: 2014 Kaiser Pool Renovation Project – Rebid. (Bids were due by 9:00 a.m. on August 12, 2014 and opened at 9:30 a.m. on August 12, 2014.)**

Jacobson noted that this meeting is a continuation of the meeting held on Tuesday, August 12, 2014. There are two projects on the agenda today. One bid for each project was missed by staff and not opened on August 12<sup>th</sup>. The bids were submitted timely.

The following additional bid was received and opened:

A motion was made and adopted to award the contract to the apparent low-qualified bidder, Altmann Construction Company, Inc., contingent upon review of the bid documents.

**BID OPENING: Excavation and Cover System Construction: 920-1000 North 1<sup>st</sup> Street Property – Riverfront Redevelopment Area. (Bids were due by 9:00 a.m. on August 12, 2014 and opened at 9:30 a.m. on August 12, 2014.)**

Jacobson stated that Integrity Grading & Excavating, Inc. was originally the apparent low bid at \$977,742.86. However, they had a mathematical error in their bid. A unit price for a lump sum item was \$29,500 and the total price was \$129,500. Therefore, their bid of \$977,742.86 is actually \$877,742.86.

The following additional bid was received and opened:
