

## HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

In compliance with Chapter 19, Wisconsin Statutes, notice of this meeting was posted and transmitted to the *Wausau Daily Herald* in the proper manner.

Chairperson Gisselman called the meeting to order at approximately 7:05 p.m. stating that a quorum was not present.

### **PUBLIC HEARING: Consider designating the Easthill Residential Historic District as a Class II Local Historic District**

---

Gisselman gave a brief summary of the Easthill Residential Historic District. In 2011, an informational meeting on the Andrew Warren Historic District and Easthill Residential Historic District was held. The districts are listed on the national register. On October 24, 2012, a public hearing was held considering the designation of the Easthill Residential Historic District and Andrew Warrens Historic District as Class II local historical districts. The Andrew Warrens Historic District was designated as a Class II historic district and is now part of the City of Wausau Ordinance. During the public hearings, there was confusion on the exact boundaries of the Easthill Residential Historic District. Since the previous public hearing, the boundaries were researched and now reflect the boundaries of the national register. The updated maps were mailed along with the notice. Gisselman defined a Class II local Historic District, as noted in the Wausau Municipal Code. The designation is advisory only. The public hearing is the first step of the designation. After the Historic Preservation Commission votes on the item, it will be sent to Plan Commission and Common Council.

Gisselman closed the public hearing.

Action on this item will be postponed to the next meeting, since a quorum was not present.
