Certificate of Appropriateness for 317 North 1st Street

Gisselman said that the sign will be on the east side of the building facing south. A meeting was scheduled for last week, but there wasn't a quorum. Gisselman said that Crooks said that he felt the font was too modern and that it should be more of block style lettering.

Oberbeck asked if it is the same type of font on the other types of signage for the Federal Building. Hebert said the monument has similar font and also has the logo. Oberbeck said he likes how it fits over the entrance. The sign doesn't compete with the building. It is simple. Tryczak said the sign looks fine. Oberbeck said it is simple and identifies the entrance. Gisselman said it is nice that the Federal Building name is attached to the apartment complex. Gisselman asked the commission about the size and font. Oberbeck said the color may be more evident on the building and it is like an art deco design.

Oberbeck motioned to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for 317 North 1st Street. Tryczak seconded and the motion carried unanimously 3-0.
