4) Clean it Up, Wausau Planning

Discussion ensued around the date for this year's event. It was decided to go with one day – Saturday, October 5, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. It will be communicated to the residents that if they can't drop items off during that time that they can take electronics to Good News Project on "such and such" date. Volunteers will be needed and we should publish this in the city newsletter. Goodwill needs to be contacted to see if they will participate this year.
