### 1) Approval of Minutes

### 2) Bike & Pedestrian Update

Aaron Ruff gave an MPO (Metropolitan Planning Organization) overview. The Bike Rodeo & Safety Day is coming up on Sat, May 10, 2014 at the MC Library. There is construction starting on Grand Avenue and a meeting is scheduled for Monday, 4/14/14 to discuss bicycle lanes.

### 3) Neighborhood Updates

*Forest Park* – Melissa and others sat down and talked about how to move forward. Conducting a brief postcard survey about what citizens like and dislike about their neighborhood. This will give residents an opportunity to voice their concerns. Perceived concerns are different in different areas of the neighborhood. They will go to the May meeting. Melissa will provide a “Pushback against Drugs” outreach.

### 4) Bike Trail Clean-up

This will take place on Wednesday, April 16, 2014. (At the typing of these minutes, the Bike Trail Clean-up was rescheduled due to inclement weather and then cancelled again due to inclement weather.)

### 5) Old/New Business

The Neighbors Place is taking used bicycles and repairing them and placing them back in use for residents who need them. They currently have 50-60 bikes and are encouraging people to get their used bikes over to the facility.
