2) Neighborhood Updates

They will be working on the North Central Health Care smoking issue in the future.

Westies – This group met last Monday and they had an informal “town hall” format. Deb Ryan would like to have an Alderperson present. They currently have a facebook page and are exploring website possibilities. They are looking up the Nextdoor Westies of Wausau social medial site to allow neighbors to connect. This site will also offer free services such as babysitting and provide information about garage sales or crime or drugs in the area. Twelve neighbors have already signed up.

Forest Park Neighborhood – On August 7th they will hold a Neighborhood Picnic at 6:30 p.m. in the Forest Park. They are going to continue to meet on a monthly basis on the 1st Thursday at 6:30pm at Forest Park Village. There will be an AODA PUSHBACK outreach in this area on July 31, 2014 from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m.

East Towne Neighborhood – Currently they have some speed and alley issues that they are working on. Sue Nowak will be bringing students from NTC to their next meeting to provide education on neighborhood revitalization. They are holding a Community Garden Block Party event on August 9 from 11:00 – 2:00 p.m.

The next Homeless Count “Point in Time” will be held on Wednesday, July 30, 2014 from 11pm – 2:00am and from 3:00am – 5:30am.
