1) Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Holster and seconded by Herring to approve the August 21, 2015 draft minutes with appropriate changes that Joan Jackson brought to our attention. Motion carried by voice vote. Motion approved.

2) Clean It Up, Wausau Discussion

5R Processors have agreed to take all electronics this year and will charge a flat-rate fee of \$20 for all TV's and Monitors. All small electronics with cords will be free unless a resident drops off 5 or more, they will be assessed a \$10 fee. Schultz Recycling is on board and will collect all appliances. DPW crew will be available to assist on both days, therefore a few volunteers from the N2N committee is welcome but not necessary. Herring has agreed to send a letter to Good News Project thanking them for their previous participation. It was asked by Radtke if 5R Processors will be taking refrigerators also, since they collect them for parts and refurbish them at their Wausau plant. At the typing of these minutes, Groeschel contacted 5R and they only wish to collect electronics at this event, no refrigerators.
