1) Approval of Minutes

Further discussion will take place next month when the numbers are in.

Southeast Side - Officer Stetzer attended their last meeting. They are looking at opportunities at John Marshall School and hoping to update Alexander Park.

Forest Park Neighborhood - Nothing to report

Westies - There was a recent drug bust on 4th Avenue. They are working cooperatively with the Downtown River District and there is another group within their neighborhood that is conducting a few small "Clean-up" weekend events.

Riverview Neighborhood - They are joining Nextdoor.com. Ric M from Public Works attended their last meeting and spoke about the leaf pick-up. They are looking into a partnership with Riverview School and they hold their meetings at Good Shepherd Church. Next month, Ms. Groat is attending to talk about the new garbage/recycling contract. Their next meeting is scheduled for Monday, November 16th.

East Side - They are talking about extending their boundaries as they don't get a large number of attendees at their meetings. Deanna is currently doing knock and talks.

1) Approval of Minutes

The November N2N Meeting was not held due to lack of agenda items. The minutes from the October Meeting were posted on the City of Wausau website but were inadvertently missed from distribution with today's agenda; therefore no motion to approve these minutes was brought forth. 2) Clean It Up, Wausau Discussion

A copy of the Clean-It-Up, Wausau statistics was drafted and distributed to the N2N Members for their discussion. It was suggested that residents enter the yard waste site from the north next time to alleviate traffic congestion.

3) Neighborhood Updates

Riverview Neighborhood - There were approximately 100 residents that attended their last meeting held in November. Finance Director, Groat was a guest speaker and provided information on the new Refuse and Recycling contract. Speeding cars continues to be an issue in their neighborhood. They are looking into asking a scout troop to assist residents in hauling their junk to the yard waste site at the next Clean It Up, Wausau event.

Forest Park Neighborhood - Their next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 6:30pm. They have invited a guest speaker from the Warming Center. They've had some mail box theft issues within their neighborhood, recently.

EastTowne Neighborhood - They are talking about a possible cook-out this summer instead of a Block Party that they've had in the past.

Officer Stetzer provided an update on the Problem Property Committee that is made up of staff members from the Inspections Dept, Community Development, Police Dept., Public Works Department and the Engineering Department.

4) Old/New Business

A new automatic crime reporting software will be installed by the end of January in the Police Department. This is called Raids On-line. The Committee would like to choose two dates for the Clean It Up, Wausau event at the next January meeting. A motion to adjourn was made by Holster and seconded by Radtke.
