1) Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Dina and seconded by Holster to approve the 7/15/16 minutes. The motion carried unanimously and the minutes will be placed on file.

2) Clean It Up, Wausau Fall Event

The Public Works Department assured the Good News Project that more man-power will be available at the Fall Clean It Up event for the heavy lifting. Public Works received permission from the Mayor to employ overtime of some of his employees on Saturday, 9/17/16. Good News will call the Volunteer Connection of the United Way to see if other volunteers are available. Per Mohelnitzky - they are working on a plan to alleviate long lines and will have a more efficient drive-layout at the yard waste site.

3) Neighborhood Updates

Southeast Side - The "Run the Runway" 5K will be held on Saturday, October 1, 2016 at 3:00pm at the Downtown Airport. Individual fees are \$25 the day of the race and families are \$60. All proceeds will go to the Alexander Airport Park Project.

East Towne - In place of their monthly meetings, they held monthly cookouts with various smaller groups within their neighborhood this summer. They will be going back to a meeting structure in September and have asked Groeschel for assistance in copying flyers to notify their residents. They have been set up on NEXTDOOR.COM but aren't real familiar with how it is working and it was suggested that they get with Marie Schmidt to get an overview of how this site works and how they can communicate with their residents in an effective way.

4) Old/New Business/Future Agenda Items

Holster asked about liability issues that they as a Neighborhood Group may encounter. He would like clarification of how they as a group are covered in the event something happens at their meetings or small cookouts, or any other event any of the Neighborhood Groups may have. Mayor said he would look into this with the city's Legal Department.

A motion to adjourn was made by Dina and seconded by Holster. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 a.m.

Next meeting is scheduled for October 21, due to the Clean It Up event scheduled on September 16, 2016.
