Minutes of previous meeting(s) (2/16/15)

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to approve the minutes of the previous meeting (2/16/15). Motion carried 5-0.

Consider various license applications.

Rasmussen stated all of the special event applications for Wausau Events 2015 season were in the packets. She indicated the Event for Equality is being pulled out and deferred to the April meeting as the organizer was unable to attend this meeting.

Rasmussen stated Amber Piette's application for an Operator's License was recommended for denial by Chief Hardel; it was noted Amber was not present to address the committee.

Motion by Wagner, second by Neal to approve or deny the various licenses as recommended by staff. Motion carried 5-0.

Consider bids submitted for new Refuse & Recycling Contract to be effective 1/1/2016, and take action regarding recommendations to Council on selection of contractor and various options contained in the bids including: term of contract; manual v. automated collection; and, selection and ownership of carts for refuse and recycling.

Maryanne Groat, Finance Director, explained they looked at maintaining our existing level of service to all residential properties, including multi-family units, totaling 16,633 units; or to go to an automated system, which would only include multi-family units of up to four, totaling 14,483 units. They took quotes for these two levels of services, looking at a variety of cart sizes and all of the other ancillary services that we may need, such as yard waste pickup, large item pickup for a cost, as well as providing extra carts for those that want them and spring cleanup. A pre-bid conference was conducted with all of the interested parties and pre-qualifications were required. The Board of Public Works pre-qualified Advance Disposal, Waste Management, Eagle Recycling, and Harter's Fox Valley Disposal. She indicated Harter's was the low bid. Under the current quotes in the first year the lowest proposal for manual service would save us \$105,000; under the automated with the contractor owning the carts, the savings would be \$172,000 in the five year contract. She recommended going with Harter's with the 10 year contract and to have the contractor own the carts, which would save the city from having to purchase, maintain and track them.

Rasmussen stated the committee needs to decide what level of service to provide to residents, whether remain manual or go to an automated system.

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to approve an automated carted system with the contractor owning the carts. Motion carried 5-0.

Rasmussen stated the next decision was to select a contractor and decide the optimal length of the contract. She noted the options were for 5 years, 7 years, or 10 years. Neal commented 10 years was a long commitment should we have any issues with the contractor. Wagner felt it was important to lock in long range relationships and the 10 year contract also comes with extra savings.

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to approve awarding the contract to the lowest bidder, Harter's Fox Valley Disposal for a 10 year term; and to authorize a budget of \$15,000 for staff to use for public education and outreach. Motion carried 5-0.

Ordinance Amending Section 8.08.011 Keeping of honey bees, regarding waiver of requirements.

Rasmussen stated this would allow Humane Office Bishop to work with homeowners for waivers when it is practical to do so. Alfonso stated upon written request they can decide on a case by case basis to grant a waiver of certain restrictions.

Motion by Wagner, second by Neal to approve the amendment to 8.08.011 Keep of honey bees. Motion carried 5-0.

Application for Apiary (Beekeeper) Permit with request for variance.

Motion by Wagner, second by Kellbach to approve the request for a variance or waiver as presented at that the last meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Operations Report from Fire Department for February 2015

No discussion, report placed on file.

Tavern Activities / Compliance Checks / Law Enforcement Activities

Hardel presented the Tavern Report for February 6, 2015 through March 06, 2015. (*See attached.*)

Hardel noted restaurant compliance checks were done and are in the report; in the past they were not done as much due to short staffing levels.

Communications

Neal requested an update on the recent stabbing death on the east side in relation to gang activity for a future meeting. Hardel noted they reached out to Wausau School District to see if they would want to partner with us and we have set a Community Forum for this Thursday at 6:30 p.m., at Wausau East High School.

Rasmussen noted there will be a presentation by the Trap, Neuter, Return volunteer group at the meeting in April. Groat requested they add a \$15,000 budget for educational outreach regarding the garbage/recycling contract to the original motion voted earlier; committee agreed.

Adjournment

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.

Minutes of previous meeting(s) (3/16/15)

Deb Ryan, 702 Elm St, addressed the committee stating that she objected to the minutes because she was not listed as being present at the meeting and comments she made on refuse and recycling were not reflected. Rayala explained there were many people present for that meeting so the audience members were not individually listed. She noted it was not a public hearing and therefore did not require including public comment; legally only motions and votes are required in minutes. Neal suggested correcting the minutes to show Deb Ryan as present and to listen to the recording and add any point she may have made. Rayala indicated the minutes would be brought back to the next meeting.

Consider various license applications.

Rasmussen indicated there was one Operator's License recommended for denial for Erin Sobjeck.

Erin Sobjeck, 725 ½ S 5th Ave, addressed the committee stating she has been working from 8AM – 11PM from 7 to 26 days in a row doing two to three jobs and would like time to be able to go back to school. If she bartended she would have more time to attend school during the day and still make money to pay her bills. She stated she has had an Ignition Interlock Device on her car since March 2013 and does not intend to ever make that mistake again.

Hardel explained the reason for the denial was two OWI convictions within the past five years; her first one was in September 2010 and the second in February 2013. He noted the first offense will fall off or outside of the five year parameter in September of this year. He questioned if she is allowed to drink where she currently bartends. Sobjeck responded that she chooses not to. Hardel indicated he would support whatever the committee decided to do since she was very close to having the first conviction drop off. Wagner questioned the time periods for licensing and renewal. Goede explained the current license would expire June 30, 2015 and she would renew for a two year period of July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2017. Wagner suggested the renewal be for only one year as a kind of probationary period and the following renewal could be for two years.

Motion by Wagner, second by Neal to approve the Operator's License for Erin Sobjeck for the year ending June 30, 2015 and renew as a One Year Restricted. Motion carried 4-1. (*Rasmussen was the dissenting vote.*)

Rasmussen requested they vote on the Temporary Class B Retailers (Picnic) license for Marathon County Historical Society separately from the other licenses as well because Gisselman intended to abstain.

Motion by Wagner, second by Kellbach to approve the picnic license for the Marathon County Historical Society. Motion carried 4-0-1, with one abstention. (*Gisselman abstained due to his association with the Historical Society.*)

Rayala indicated Shannon Thomas was present to answer any questions or concerns the committee may have regarding issues with The Event for Equality. Rasmussen questioned if Ms. Thomas had collaborated with the Police Department over the problems at last year's event. Thomas indicated that she did meet with the Police Department and will ensure the music and event is family-friendly. Hardel stated Cpt Barnes met with Ms. Thomas and all of the concerns from last year were addressed.

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to approve the rest of the licenses on the list. Motion carried 5-0.

Consider request of Wisconsin Woodchucks for Pre-Game Outdoor Bands for 2015 Season at Athletic Park.

Rasmussen explained the Woodchucks are requesting the same thing they had last year with pre-game bands.

Gisselman stated he did not receive any complaints or hear of any problems and did not oppose the request.

All the bands will perform on Saturdays from 5:00pm to 7:00pm at Athletic Park; the game's first pitch is 7:05 pm. They are also requesting an Opening Day performance on Friday May 29th starting at 5:00pm to 7:00pm.

Motion by Gisselman, second by Neal to approve Pre-Game Outdoor Bands for the Woodchucks for 2015. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action on amending Section 8.08.120(c) Pet Fancier Permit

Alfonso explained a citizen contacted the city who would like to be able to foster dogs and cats for the animal shelter and other non-profit organizations under the Pet Fancier Permit. She explained the issue is that the dog and cat license requirement makes this difficult because people who are fostering pets don't have the animals long term and therefore don't want to license them. She stated that Human Officer Bishop indicated she had no objection to excluding people who are fostering animals from this requirement. She noted they would still have to prove evidence that the animals are vaccinated.

Motion by Kellbach, second by Neal to approve the amendment to Section 8.08.120(c). Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action on amending Section 8.08.170 Licenses.

Alfonso stated this relates to the previous amendment exempting dogs and cats from the license requirement under the license and pet fancier section of the code for foster care.

Motion by Wagner, second by Gisselman to approve the amendment to Section 8.08.170. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action on amending Section 8.08.011(g) Definitions

Alfonso stated this relates to the previous amendments defining temporary foster care.

Motion by Neal, second by Wagner to approve the amendment to Section 8.08.011(g). Motion carried 5-0.

Property Maintenance and Inspection Report

Bill Hebert stated the first quarter they focused on implementing the residential rental licensing ordinance. He indicated they completed approximately 400 inspections through the time of this report. Most of the issues were typically carbon monoxide and smoke alarms, handrail, guardrail and occasional electrical or plumbing. He felt the landlords and the tenants, for the most part, have been very cooperative. He stated they were falling a little behind on the goal that was set for anticipated number of inspections, so they are considering working with Community Development to utilize some of their personnel to assist with some inspections. *(Report placed on file.)*

Operations Report from Fire Department for March 2015

Chief Kujawa stated they will be taking delivery of their new engine this evening. She noted firefighter/medic, Nick Gering, was given the Americanism Award through the VFW, which is awarded to individuals that show professionalism in their jobs, and outstanding performance.

Tavern Activities / Compliance Checks / Law Enforcement Activities

Hardele presented the Tavern Report for March 7, 2015 through April 9, 2015. *(See attached.)* Hardele noted Lt Michael Felder will be taking over the Tavern Activities Report for Lt. Todd Baeten. *(Report placed on file.)*

Ofc. Nick Stetzer, Wausau Police Department and Paula Schultz, facilitator for the Marathon County Restorative Justice Program, addressed the committee to explain the program. Stetzer stated it is designed to educate teen drivers, who are cited for violation of a red flashing light, running a stop sign/light, etc., by offering this program to as an alternative to just paying a fine. The program consists of an hour meeting with an officer and the facilitator, where they discuss the violation and what harm was caused by it or what potentially could have happened. They also discuss the interaction they had with law enforcement in an attempt to build a positive relationship with the person and the police. After the hour meeting they will have to complete specified hours of community service and an write an essay to the judge, facilitator and officer. He stated they ask that they write about their experience receiving the citation, dealing with the officer and what they learned from the program. Stetzer indicated there have been a lot of good comments from parents and teens. He noted they had 52 teens in the program so far with an 83% success rate. Rasmussen commented she was glad they took the initiative to test this as a pilot program and questioned if an ordinance change was necessary to keep it going.

Alfonso stated the Restorative Justice Program will need to be approved by Council like the Peer Court was, because the citation is dismissed if they successfully complete the program. The Council can decide if they want to stick it

to probationary drivers or give these young people a chance. She pointed out when operating under a probationary license, the first citation carries the appropriate points, but the second citation doubles them. Parents are typically in a panic because of the insurance and the kids are in a predicament because of doubling points. She indicated she was very much in favor of the program.

Motion by Neal, second by Kellbach to support and recommend continuance of the Restorative Justice Program to the Common Council. Motion carried 5-0.

Presentation by local volunteer group for Trap, Neuter, Return cat management and discussion of related plan and concept.

Amie Leanoff, Community Cat Action Team (CCAT), presented a proposal for the reduction of feral cat population in the Wausau Metro area. The presentation highlighted the vision statement, issue, proposed model, long-range plan, funding, target areas and requested cooperation from the city through some ordinance amendments. (*Proposal on file with Clerk's Office and online on Calendar in committee packet, audio also available upon request.*) Committee discussion followed.

Susan Haug, Ringle, author of the Bird City application for the City of Wausau, addressed the committee to point out the average feral cat kills 100 birds per year and 33 species have become extinct worldwide. She noted she loves cats and owns one herself. She commented she did not believe TNR was effective and that it would take 7-10 years to control the feral cat population. Leanoff responded the alternative the bird conservancy recommends is basically widespread mass trapping and eradication, which she felt was something that would be a very difficult sell for the community.

Rasmussen indicated this would be brought back to a future meeting for committee action.

**COMMENTS REGARDING PROPOSED
ORDINANCE TO ENABLE IMPLEMENTATION OF
TRAP, NEUTER, RELEASE PROGRAM FOR FERAL AND STRAY CATS
BY CITIZEN VOLUNTEER GROUP**

- The City of Wausau has been requested to consider allowing a pilot trap, neuter, release program. In order to do so, certain changes are needed to chapter 8 of the Wausau Municipal Code that governs the care and control of animals.
- The draft ordinance sets up parameters for caregivers of feral and stray cats in a pilot area to give care to such animals without being held in violation of certain ordinance provisions such as sections 8.080.030, Dognapping and catnapping; 8.08.120, Number of dogs and cats limited; 8.08.170, Licenses; and, 8.08.190, Animals not to run at large. It is unclear at the time of drafting this ordinance, the exact parameters of the pilot area, and that area would need to be more clearly identified.
- The draft ordinance also seeks to ensure individuals who are caregivers of feral and stray cats under an “authorized TNR program” operated by a local organization known as Community Cat Action Team (CCAT) are distinguishable from individuals who may simply desire to own numerous cats.
- In speaking with the Humane Society of Marathon County Humane, Inc., (HSMC) the CCAT will apparently not be sponsored by or operated under the auspices of its organization.
- In the event a feral or stray cat was to be delivered to the HSMC by the CCAT, there is no provision in the draft ordinance that would authorize or obligate the City to pay for such surrender or delivery of the animal to the HSMC. However, the City would still be obligated to pay for animals delivered to the HSMC by animal control and/or the police department.
- Since the City will be relieving caregivers of feral and stray cats under an authorized TNR program from liability under certain municipal ordinances, the proposed ordinance seeks to define the responsibilities of caregivers and the authorized TNR program in managing colonies of feral cats in an effort, to the extent possible, minimize inconvenience and nuisance to the surrounding community area.
- It is unclear as to how a TNR program will distinguish between a cat that has an owner but is perhaps “at large” or “free-roaming,” from a stray cat without an owner but is socialized to humans. Liability potentially exists (although the amount and extent is unclear) to an individual who would vaccinate and neuter the cat of another without the permission of that owner.
- The draft ordinance provides that the CCAT must acquire liability insurance and name the City and its employees, agents, representatives and elected and appointed officials as additional insureds.

- In the event the City approves changes to ordinances, it is also strongly recommended that the City condition its approval upon CCAT providing the City with an indemnification and release in the following form through a separate document:

CCAT shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless City, its employees, agents, and elected and appointed officials from and against all liabilities, losses, judgments, actions, suits, obligations, debts, demands, damages, penalties, claims, costs, charges and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, of any kind or of any nature whatsoever which may be imposed, incurred, sustained or asserted against the City, its employees, agents, and/or elected or appointed officials by reason of any injury or death to any person, or loss, damage, or destruction of any property or loss of use thereof, or otherwise arising directly or indirectly as a result of the acts or omissions of CCAT, its agents, employees, or volunteers under its trap, neuter, release program within the City of Wausau.

CCAT hereby releases the City, its employees, agents, and elected and appointed officials from and against all liabilities, losses, judgments, actions, suits, obligations, debts, demands, damages, penalties, claims, costs, charges and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, which may arise as a result of the acts or omissions of CCAT, its agents, employees, or volunteers under its trap, neuter, release program within the City of Wausau.

- As a pilot program, the draft ordinance proposes that the TNR program be reauthorized by the Common Council prior to July 1, 2018, or it shall expire.

The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 8.08.05 Feral cat caregiver and TNR program requirements is hereby created to read as follows:

8.08.05. Feral cat caregiver and TNR program requirements. (a) Definitions. For purposes of this section, the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) “Authorized TNR program” means a TNR program directed and operated by the Community Cat Action Team, provided it remains a non-profit animal rescue or welfare group and qualifies as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and has as at least one of its purposes, the rescue and placement of cats which cannot be kept or placed by public animal control agencies or humane shelters.
- (2) “Caregiver” means any person trained and designated by an authorized TNR program as a caregiver, who in accordance with a good faith effort to trap, neuter, vaccinate and return a feral or stray cat to a feral cat colony, provides food, water or shelter to or otherwise cares for a feral or stray cat.
- (3) “Ear-tipped” means a straight line cut of the tip of the ear on a cat, typically the left ear, performed by a licensed veterinarian when a cat is under anesthesia and identifies a cat as sterilized.
- (4) “Feral cat” means a cat that is wild, untamed, or unsocialized.
- (5) “Feral cat colony” means a group of cats that congregates, more or less, together as a unit. Although not every cat in a colony may be feral, any nonferal or free-roaming cats that congregate with a colony shall be deemed to be a part of it.

- (6) “Free-roaming cat” means a cat that is regularly off the property of the owner and is not under the physical control or restraint of the owner.
- (7) “Pilot area” means that portion of the City bounded by First and Third Avenues and Stewart and _____ Avenue.
- (8) “Stray cat” means a cat that is socialized to humans and does not have an owner.
- (9) “TNR” means a trap, neuter and return program pursuant to which feral and stray cats are trapped, neutered or spayed, vaccinated against rabies, ear tipped and returned to the original location where they live.

(b) Feral cat colonies shall be permitted within the pilot area only, and caregivers shall be entitled to maintain such colonies in such pilot area upon strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this section.

- (1) Registration of the feral cat colony with the authorized TNR program.
- (2) Taking reasonable steps to obtain the vaccination of the colony population for rabies and making reasonable efforts to update the vaccinations on cats that can be recaptured.
- (3) Taking reasonable steps to result in the spay/neuter, by a licensed veterinarian, of the colony population.
- (4) Taking reasonable steps to find permanent, inside homes for colony cats that exhibit the potential for acclimating to such a placement.
- (5) Providing adequate containment and disposal of excrement. Caregivers shall be subject to the provisions of section 8.08.220 notwithstanding any provision of section 8.08.001(f).
- (6) Taking reasonable steps to prevent feral colony cats from creating a nuisance on adjacent properties.
- (7) In the event that kittens are born to a colony cat, the caregiver shall take reasonable steps likely to result in the removal of the kittens from the feral cat colony after they have been weaned, and obtain placement of the kittens in homes, foster homes or animal rescue facilities.
- (8) Immediately report to the City Animal Control Officer any cat that appears to be ill, diseased, or to have been exposed to potentially suffering from rabies. Caregivers shall be subject to the provisions of section 8.08.240 notwithstanding any provision of section 8.08.001(f).

(c) The authorized TNR program shall comply with the provisions of this subsection.

- (1) Review and approve caregivers.
- (2) Help to resolve complaints over the conduct of a feral cat colony caregiver or of cats within a colony.
- (3) Provide the City Animal Control Officer on an annual basis, or upon other reasonable request, with information relating to the authorized TNR program including number of cats and kittens spayed and neutered, number of cats and kittens placed in permanent homes, a list of the names and addresses of approved caregivers, and the number of colonies and number of cats in each feral cat colony.
- (4) Maintain liability insurance for all activities, actions and work performed under in connection with the authorized TNR program with a minimum combined single limit in an amount not less than \$1 million dollars of liability per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage and furnish the City with a Certificate of Insurance naming the City, its employees, agents, representatives, and elected and appointed officials as additional insureds. The policy of insurance shall state that coverage shall not be cancelled by the insurer in less than thirty (30) days after the insured and the City have received written notice of such cancellation

(d) It shall be an affirmative defense to prosecution under sections 8.08.030, Dognapping and catnapping; 8.08.120, Number of dogs and cats limited; 8.08.170, Licenses; and, 8.08.190, Animals not to run at large, that the animal is a feral or stray cat provided care by a caregiver in the pilot area through the authorized TNR program.

(e) The authorization of this program and ordinance and designation of the authorized TNR program shall expire on July 1, 2018, unless reauthorized by the common council.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of publication.

WHEREAS, the ability of the City and other communities similarly situated to issue “Class C” wine licenses to painting studios would require the Wisconsin State Legislature to enact additional amendments to certain alcohol licensing laws set forth in chapter 125, Wisconsin Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Common Council of the City of Wausau urges the Wisconsin State Legislature to enact additional changes to the alcohol licensing laws set forth in chapter 125, Wisconsin Statutes to permit it and other communities similarly situated to issue “Class C” wine licenses to painting studios so as not to deplete its limited quota of Class B Beer & Liquor licenses;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to forward this Resolution to our local State Legislatures, the Governor, and the Wisconsin League of Municipalities.

(d) “Domesticated cat or dog” means a cat or dog that is socialized to humans and is appropriate as a companion for humans.

(~~d~~)(e) “Farm animal/poultry” means any warmblooded animal/fowl . . .

(e)(f) “Owner” means any individual, partnership or corporation that has the right of property in an animal or who keeps, harbors, cares for, acts as its custodian, or who knowingly permits an animal to remain on or about his/premises/property for five or more consecutive days. For purposes of this chapter, any individual located within the pilot area as defined in section 8.08.05(7), designated in writing by a City authorized TNR program, who acts as a caregiver for a feral or stray cat that has been ear tipped as part of a TNR program shall not be deemed to be an owner of such feral or stray cat; provided however, that such individual complies with the provisions of Section 8.08.05 and provides a copy of the written designation to appropriate City officials upon request.

(~~f~~)(g) “Pet” means and animal kept for pleasure rather than utility, which may/may not be susceptible to rabies.

(~~g~~)(h) “Temporary foster care” means the care of a dog or cat by a person residing in a single or two family dwelling unit for 6 months or less and where such animal has been placed in the care of such person by a non-profit animal rescue, shelter, or welfare group qualifying as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(h)(i) “Unprovoked bite” means not stimulated to produce an angry or vexed reaction.

(i)(j) “U.S.D.A. approved rabies vaccine” means rabies vaccine for dogs, cats, horses, cows or sheep only. (Ord. 61-4774 § 1, 1992; Ord. 61-4677 § 1 (part), 1989.)




Sales By Month
