Meeting Minutes

Wausau River District Meeting

Monday, June 1, 2015 at 2:00 PM (Dudley Tower)

The following businesses were represented at the meeting with a total of 12 persons in attendance:

This meeting focused upon the impact that homelessness, public intoxication, and associated nuisance activity have upon the quality of life in the 400 Block as well as the financial impact on nearby businesses. The following are concerns and solutions offered by business employees/owners.

CONCERNS

- An inappropriate use of bathroom facilities by these individuals (e.g. showering in the sink), which often leaves the bathrooms in an unsanitary condition. Kicking the individuals out causes a displacement issue where they go to a neighboring business.
- Visitors of the 400 Block are avoiding 3rd Street in light of the concentration of homeless/intoxicated individuals who congregate at the tables.
- Some customers have reduced the frequency at which they visit certain businesses in light of the presence of homeless/intoxicated individuals. This has caused a reduction in revenue.
- The interaction between homeless/intoxicated individuals is often "bizarre," if not "disorderly," and creates an uncomfortable and undesirable environment for visitors/customers. Specifically, lewd looks, unwanted comments, and "catcalls" are commonplace.
- Two or three tables are often times pushed together by homeless/intoxicated individuals or by residents of the Landmark. This restricts the use of tables for others while encouraging undesirable behavior.

SOLUTIONS - *The following represents the majority opinion*

- Limit alcohol use on the 400 Block to special events thereby prohibiting consumption of alcohol during all other times.
- Spread tables out (e.g. place some of the tables on the 4th Street side) or link tables and chairs together in such a way that prohibits individuals from pushing tables together.
- Consider installing cameras in the 400 Block with appropriate signage to deter undesirable behaviors.
- Increase police presence by walking the beat on a more frequent basis.
- Send in plain clothes CSOs/officers to identify those responsible for lewd looks and catcalls.

OTHER COMMENTS

- Restricting alcohol use to special events would have very little financial impact on business sales. The benefits of restricted alcohol use appear to outweigh the nominal revenue that would be generated.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCES AND POLICIES RELEVANT TO 400 BLOCK CONCERNS

The following is a brief summary of ordinances and policies relevant to 400 Block public safety concerns.

- **W.M.C. §9.04.026, Prohibition against public intoxication.**
No person shall, in a public place, conduct themselves in such a manner as to be intoxicated or incapacitated *and* create a public nuisance (as defined in the ordinance).
Forfeiture: \$250.00 (inclusive of costs) for first offense; \$439.00 (inclusive of costs) for subsequent offense.
- **W.M.C. §9.04.030, Loud and unnecessary noise prohibited.**
Generally prohibits noise which tends to unreasonably disturb the peace and quiet of persons in the vicinity.
Forfeiture: Currently not less than \$73.60, nor more than \$313.00 (inclusive of costs).
Bond amount: \$124.00 (inclusive of costs).
- **W.M.C. §9.04.010 adopting Wis. Stat. §944.20, Lewd and lascivious behavior.**
The relevant portion prohibits publicly and indecently exposing genitals or pubic area. (Does not apply to a mother's breast feeding of her child.)
Forfeiture: Currently not less than \$73.60, nor more than \$313.00 (inclusive of costs).
- **W.M.C. §9.04.010 adopting Wis. Stat. §947.01, Disorderly conduct.**
Generally prohibits violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or otherwise disorderly conduct under circumstances tending to cause or provoke a disturbance.
Forfeiture: Currently not less than \$73.60, nor more than \$313.00 (inclusive of costs).
Bond amount: \$250.00 (inclusive of costs).
- **W.M.C. §9.04.010 adopting Wis. Stat. §947.02, Vagrancy.**
Generally prohibits a person from being a "vagrant" defined, as relevant here, as a person, with the physical ability to work, who is without lawful means of support and does not seek employment.
Forfeiture: Currently not less than \$73.60, nor more than \$313.00 (inclusive of costs).

- **W.M.C. §9.20.020, Regulation of persons.**
Subsection (o) permits exclusion of individuals from use of park facilities for violating rules and regulations governing the use of parks.
- **City of Wausau Park Suspension Policy Adopted Pursuant to W.M.C. §9.20.020.**
Identifies procedures for the suspension of privileges for individuals to use parks within the City of Wausau in response to “Inappropriate Behavior” (as defined in the policy), violations of park rules, City ordinances, or state or federal statutes.

Ordinances which permit alcohol at the 400 Block:

- **W.M.C. §9.04.025, Consumption or possession of intoxicants on streets.**
Subsection (a) permits consumption of alcohol on the sidewalks adjoining the 400 Block.
Subsection (c) permits open containers of alcohol on the sidewalks adjoining the 400 Block.
Forfeiture: Currently not less than \$73.60, nor more than \$313.00 (inclusive of costs).
Bond amount: \$124.00 (inclusive of costs).

There are currently no ordinances restricting alcohol in City parks.


