Minutes from the January 6, 2014 Meeting

The January meeting was canceled due to severe cold. Our next meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 3, 2014.

Since we don't have any minutes from last month, this is an excellent opportunity to remind everyone that all dogs and cats in the City of Wausau must be licensed. You can obtain a license by mail, online or at City Hall. The license fee of \$10 for spayed/neutered and \$20 for unaltered pets is used solely for animal management costs. Licensing fees are an important funding mechanism for the Marathon County Humane Society operations including shelter for homeless dogs, community education and cruelty and neglect investigation. The balance of the revenues will be maintained by the City to fund animal control services. The fine for an unlicensed pet is \$177.
