Minutes from the May 4, 2015 Meeting

1. Romey updated our group on construction of the Grand Avenue Kwik Trip. It will be a gas station and convenience store (no car wash). Construction should begin as soon as the weather is better.
2. Tammy Stratz, Community Development, spoke to us about several items.
 - The park bench on the southeast corner of East Thomas and Grand Avenue should be installed within the next couple of weeks and will include a small plaque with the neighborhood name on it.
 - The Tot Lot is still planned for the corner of Prospect and Single Avenues. Community Development is working with consultants and requesting bids (per City regulations). The goal is to have it completed by this Fall.
3. Some residents expressed concerns regarding rollerblading in the street on Prospect Avenue.
4. Anne is looking for volunteers to help paint the fire hydrants in our neighborhood.
5. Anne has been receiving call about excess speed in the 800 block of Young Street.
6. The property on Plumer Street is looking better.
7. May 15th is the start of National Police Week.
8. Officer Burns attended our meeting. He was hired in January of this year and is still in training. He is a UW-Eau Claire graduate with a 4-year degree and lives in our neighborhood.
