### Minutes from the May 5, 2014 Meeting

1. Margaret Wenzel of Crossroads Community Services, Inc. spoke to us about their organization and the services they offer.
  - Crossroads was founded as a non-profit corporation in 1969 and has mailed surveys to help determine homeowner, landlord and tenant needs in specific neighborhoods. **If you received a survey (bright yellow paper in a bright yellow envelope), please send it back—they are still accepting the surveys.**
  - Their organization was founded to foster the ability of all individuals to live in a good environment and in a well maintained home. They have raised some funds to reach their goals and continue to pursue additional funding sources. They coordinate funding and volunteers in each of their designated neighborhoods.
  - They currently have 4 specific “neighborhoods”. Each neighborhood covers approximately 1 square city block with at least 50% of the residences being homeowner occupied.
2. Romey reported the City of Wausau trash collection contract ends 12/31/14. The City Council is reviewing a number of options regarding the contract.
3. A Longfellow Neighborhood bench will be placed on the corner of Grand Avenue and East Thomas Street. There is also a possibility of some simple landscaping to provide an attractive entry into our neighborhood.
