Minutes from the August 3, 2015 Meeting

- Those in attendance discussed numerous topics:
 - There has been excessive noise after 10:00 PM and a possible marijuana odor in the 700 block of Kickbusch. Residents should contact the Wausau Police Department to report these types of situations.
 - A variety of concerns have been expressed regarding a property in the 1100 block of Prospect Avenue, including loud voices coming from the home and noisy vehicles.
 - Parking issues on Single Avenue near Prospect Avenue were reported.
 - A concern had previously been expressed regarding the number of cars for sale on the property previously owned by Wausau Floral. The seller has a valid permit to sell cars at that location.
 - Always check with the City before installing a fence. There are rules that must be followed, including: the decorative side of the fence must be on the outside and the fence must be far enough off the lot line to trim on both sides of the fence.
 - There has been another heroin overdose in Wausau.
 - Both sides of East Thomas continue to be parked full from Prospect to St. Paul when Bull Falls has an event. Since this can cause serious safety issues for getting emergency vehicles through the streets, it was suggested to allow parking on only 1 side of the street during their festivals.
 - Wausau Pickers will be having a "food truck" competition on either 8/20 or 8/27. Check with them (or their Facebook page) for details.
 - Our next meeting will be the **2nd** Monday of September since the first Monday is Labor Day.
- The new Neighborhood Liaison, Officer Nate Stetzer attended our meeting and introduced himself (he replaces Officer Ben Graham (who was promoted). Congratulations to Ben on his promotion and welcome to Nate!
