LEGAL PROCEEDINGS VILLAGES OF MAINE, BROKAW & TOWN OF TEXAS

The City of Wausau is now engaged in two legal proceedings relating to the Village of Maine, the Village of Brokaw, and the Town of Texas. One of those proceedings is a lawsuit pending in Marathon County Circuit Court. The other proceeding is the statutory cooperative boundary planning process that Maine, Brokaw and Texas are using to give Maine and Texas full control over Brokaw, eventually cause the consolidation of Brokaw and Maine, and seal the Southern border of the Town of Texas. The outcomes of these legal proceedings will have profound implications for the City of Wausau, landowners in Maine and Texas who want to annex to the City, for Maine, Brokaw and Texas, and for the Marathon County region more broadly.

The best sources for information about the City's position in these proceedings are the City's complaint in the lawsuit, and the City's formal comments on the proposed Cooperative Boundary Plan. Both documents are available from the City Clerk's office. These are very important legal proceedings, and the City will respect the legal process.
