**Minutes**

Meeting called to order by Dick Rayborn

Agenda Change: Bill Duncanson, Guest Speaker – Sylvan Hill Bike Trail Plan. Draft plan came out Fall 2015. No uses of the park will be eliminated – hiking trails, cross country skiing, snow shoeing all remains. Design/build contract is getting prepared – timeline may move up. Mountain Biking Coalition has raised \$85,000 so may be started end of this summer or early next spring. People who still have issues may contact the Park Dept.

Also discussed the green ribbon campaign to bring awareness to Emerald Ash Borer issue. 20% of our boulevard trees are Ash (about 8,000 trees). There is a chemical treatment (about \$20/tree every 1-2 years) – adds up quickly. No public programs to private landowners to assist in treating trees on your property.

Police Dept Updates – Nate Stetzer

- Discussed latest *The Briefing Sheet* – highlighted financial crimes – two best tips DON'T carry your social security card with you; SHRED all documents with your names or any account numbers on them.
- 1005 Brown St. – active investigation re: drugs.

Guest Speakers

- Al Antolik – Wausau Fire Dept. Update – State Law: Smoke detectors and Carbon Monoxide detectors one of each on each floor of your home. If you don't have them in your home, there are some available at the Fire Department and the Fire Department will come and install them; the catch is the fire safety talk you have to have. Participated in a competition with Stevens Point fire department to see how many folks could be taught hands-only CPR. Stevens Point – 1350 Wausau -- 2225 There were 2343 runs between ambulance and fire since beginning of January.
- Joel Lewis (County Board Supervisor) & Michael Loy (NCHC) – Marathon County Board and NCHC Update -- will be at the next meeting to really discuss the state of the aquatic therapy pool proposals with the County. Mental health, substance abuse services, developmental disabilities, adult protective services and aquatic therapy pool are offered at NCHC as well as other services in 40 different programs. Pool is 40 years old; typical pool "lifespan" is 30 years. Exploring cost to replace pool and proposals of where to have the pool and such.

Neighborhood Updates, Questions, Idea Sharing

- Homme hosting a fundraiser at Panera on Thursday and also annual golf outing on July 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Next door – metal detectors were “scavenging” in some boulevard and yards. Police have had contact with these 2 men and explained their limitations.
- Discussed jurisdiction questions for County vs. City police


