Minutes from the June 6, 2016 Meeting

- Officer Nate Stetzer discussed several items with our group.
 - The Wausau Police Department has 10 CSOs (Community Service Officers) this year; 5 are new and 5 are returning. The CSOs take care of a number of items and free up officers for other tasks such as monitoring criminal activity.
 - The NIXLE system has replaced the Code Red system. NIXLE has been up and running for about a week and a few system issues are being addressed. Officer Nate will write up a "cheat sheet" to make it easier to sign up to receive information from NIXLE.
 - Officer Nate went over the Briefing Sheet with our group. There were 4 sexual assaults in the neighborhood within the last 2 weeks.
- Clif Ambriz (Inspections Department) will be retiring in December.
- Romey shared with us that he is trying to revise (some of the) trash container visibility rules. He would like for the rules to be more convenient for the homeowner.
