Minutes from the July 11, 2016 Meeting

1. Romey talked about the July 12th City Council meeting where they will discuss, and vote on, changing the alcohol rules for the 400 Block. Since the 400 Block is a City park, the open hours are 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM. There have been 3 different suggestions for changing the rules. One of the suggestions is to allow alcohol consumption after 4:00 PM daily or 2 hours before and 1 hour after an event that has secured a permit (i.e., weddings, Wednesday night concerts, etc.).
2. Officer Nate Stetzer passed out the current "Briefing Sheet". He also talked about several other items. There will be 2 CSO's at each of the Woodchuck's games during the summer. Nate also let us know that NIXLE is up and running. E-mails and texts have been sent for the last 2 months (you can sign up if you're interested; more information included with the newsletter). The Department is still compiling telephone numbers to include in the robo-calls so only the appropriate households are contacted.
3. Landlord licensing was discussed. The City can still require licensing but can no longer inspect rental properties.



Log in at **www.nixle.com**

Click **“Locations”** tab

Click **“Add New Location”** to add addresses in your town or around the country. Do your relatives live out of the area? Keep track of what’s happening near your loved ones and the places you work, live, or visit.

Click **“Settings”** tab

Select a location from the left-hand menu and subscribe to receive messages from each agency by checking the “Subscribe” option. Adjust which messages by priority level are sent to your email and/or cell phone. **Please note: you must opt-in to receive messages from non-public safety agencies.**
