Minutes from the August 1, 2016 Meeting

1. There were multiple items discussed by those who attended the meeting:
 - The railroad tracks on Single Avenue are in very poor shape.
 - Current telephone scams are “IRS” calls (they would never contact you by phone) and computer repairs (saying your computer has a problem and they can fix it).
 - The City of Wausau is taking bids for the Tot Lot on the corner of Prospect and Single.
 - The Waste Management site in Ringle will accept oil paints, etc. at no cost.
 - There have been several instances of parking issues in the 800 block of Henrietta (near Prospect). Vehicles are parked too close to the end of driveways and even/odd parking restrictions are not being followed (the even/odd parking rules don’t apply if there are “no parking this side of street” signs posted in the location).
 - Contact the Inspections Department if lawns aren’t being cut.
 - The Better Business Bureau (BBB) can be contacted for complaints about unwanted solicitations from specific companies.
 - There was a suggestion to put up speed limit signs on Curling Drive.
2. Officer Nate Stetzer passed out the current “Briefing Sheet” and talked about several other items. A NIXLE program press release is scheduled to be put on the City website (hopefully this week). General NIXLE information includes “Coffee With A Cop”, emergency/storm information, etc. If you sign up to receive information from NIXLE, your number can’t be sold to anyone. You can access NIXLE information via the City or Police Department websites (including The Briefing Sheet). The next “Coffee With A Cop” is scheduled for 7:00 AM on 8/23 at Vino Latte. Raidsonline information is updated every 12 hours.
