## Minutes from the September 12, 2016 Meeting

1. One resident noted there seems to be a large number of semi trucks traveling on Prospect Avenue at all hours of the day and night.
2. Romey will ask Eric Lindman, the Public Works Director, to address our meeting next month to discuss snow routes, sand barrels, parking, etc.
3. Tammy Stratz, Community Development, updated our group on the status of the Tot Lot. The City did receive any bids for our Tot lot so the Parks Department will now assist us with obtaining the equipment; a Spring opening is planned. The Tot Lot will be for children under 5 years old and will have 3-4 pieces of equipment, benches and tables.
4. Tammy also requested input on identification for the neighborhood. Banners, signs, etc. hung on light poles along the neighborhood boundaries and Prospect Avenue. The merits of banners vs signs were discussed. A banner with a generic bell shape is the preferred design (if signs are less expensive, that is acceptable). Color suggestions were yellow with medium blue lettering or white with blue letters; the bell and the lettering would be the same color.
5. Officer Nate Stetzer passed out the current "Briefing Sheet" and discussed the information and statistics contained in it.
