8th Annual “CLEAN IT UP, WAUSAU” Event

The City of Wausau is proud to host the 8th annual “**Clean it Up, Wausau**” event on Friday and Saturday, April 15, 16 from 9:00am to 5:00pm at the east end of the Wausau Yard Waste Site at the end of Chellis Street.

To continue to provide quality service and a clean environment for the City of Wausau residents, Mayor Jim Tipple's N2N (Neighbor to Neighbor) Committee is partnering with The Good News Project and Schulz Recycling to bring you the opportunity to dispose of electronics, appliances, furniture and other unwanted items. A **City of Wausau Proof of Residence** is required for disposal. Some disposal fees apply. See below acceptable and non-acceptable items.

Acceptable:

- Furniture, Mattresses, Box Springs, Tables, Chairs, Sofas
- Appliances containing Freon (refrigerators, dehumidifiers, air conditioners)
- Lawnmowers, snow blowers, washers, dryers, stoves, power tools
- Scrap metal
- Batteries
- Tires
- Electronics, Computers, Monitors, TV's, Keyboards, Printers, Scanners, Microwaves, Cell phones, and just about any electronic with a cord.

Non Acceptable:

- Light bulbs
- Liquids, Oil, paint, chemicals
- Remodeling waste, roofing materials
- Medications – Take to RX Drop-box located at the Police Department
