

PLANNING YOUR TRIP
All METRO RIDE bus routes on this map are represented by a route number and a color. The bus you want to catch will have a sign above the windshield that says EXPRESS. The route number will also be displayed in the corner of this sign above the windshield. There is a sign with similar information on the curb side of the bus, near the front door.

CATCHING THE BUS
Go to the street on which your route operates and locate a bus stop sign. Stand at the bus stop sign and wait for the bus to arrive. When the bus stop is obstructed by snow, wait at the nearest opening in the snow bank, such as a driveway or crosswalk. Metro Ride does not remove snow from bus stops. When you see the bus coming, step up to the curb and hail it by waving. Get aboard quickly, pay your fare or show your pass, and take a seat.

ON-BOARD THE BUS
You want a safe, clean, comfortable ride. Be considerate and follow METRO RIDE simple, common sense rules. (See DO's and DON'T's)

GETTING OFF THE BUS
About one block before you get to your bus stop, pull the cord along the top of the windows to signal the driver that you want to get off. If another rider has requested your stop, you don't need to pull the cord again. Please remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop. When the bus has stopped moving, exit through either door and wait until the bus has pulled away before starting to cross the street. Because the bus is so large, car drivers cannot see you stepping out in front of or behind it.

As much as possible you should avoid moving about while the bus is in motion, particularly in wet or snowy weather when the bus floor is likely to be slippery.

TRANSFERS
You can transfer between express routes and regular routes if the two routes intersect. Please refer to the METRO RIDE regular route map and schedule for more information.

REGULAR BUS ROUTES
METRO RIDE also operates regular routes which go near most Wausau area schools. If the routes in this express guide do not meet your needs, check a METRO RIDE regular route map or call METRO RIDE at 715-842-9287.



The routes shown in this guide are designed to enhance our regular routes and accommodate the increased passenger loads during the school year. These routes will run only on school days. All of the routes in this guide are available to the general public.

Students:
(Kindergarten thru Senior High)
Cash \$1.50
Tokens 10 for \$8.50
Monthly Pass \$19.00

Senior Citizens:
(65 years of age or over, with Medicare Card or proper ID card issued by METRO RIDE)
Cash \$0.85
Monthly Pass \$19.00

NOTE: Student tickets and bus passes sold by METRO RIDE can be used on any route, on any day that METRO RIDE operates.

Disabled:
(With Medicare Card or proper ID card issued by METRO RIDE)
Cash \$0.85
Monthly Pass \$19.00

Adults:
Cash \$1.75
Tokens 10 for \$10.00
Monthly Pass \$38.00

Children:
(Under age 5, accompanied by an adult) Free

TRANSPORTATION FOR THE DISABLED

ALL METRO RIDE busses are equipped with wheelchair lifts or ramps. If you are disabled and unable to use a METRO RIDE bus, you may qualify for METRO RIDE paratransit service. For more information, call METRO RIDE at 715-842-9287.



DON'T

- smoke, chew tobacco, or use e-cigarettes.
- eat or drink.
- play a radio, tape player or other electronic device unless you use headphones.
- be boisterous or push or scuffle.
- put your feet on the seats, seat backs, or walls.
- leave trash on the bus.
- hang out the windows.
- throw or spit anything out of the bus window.
- bring bulky items on the bus especially at bus times.
- bring animals, except service animals, onto the bus or transit system property unless enclosed in a container that can be held on your lap.
- bring weapons or hazardous materials aboard the bus.

DO

- ask your driver for help if you need directions.
- take a seat if one is available and remain seated while the bus is moving.
- listen to and obey instructions given by the driver.
- give your seat to any person who, because of age or physical condition, is less able to stand than you are.
- read informational hand-outs and notices posted in the bus.
- wear proper clothing. (Shirts and shoes are required. Ice skates and roller skates should not be worn on the bus.)
- fold up child strollers so the aisle remains clear for passengers.
- enjoy your ride.

Drivers may ask riders who do not observe these rules to leave the bus.
