

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

Chairperson Gisselman called the meeting to order at approximately 4:00 p.m. stating that a quorum was present.

Discussion and possible action on supporting preservation of the historic structure at 813 North 2nd Street (Mark's House).

Gisselman said that this item is to approve the resolution that would be forwarded to Common Council in January. Lenz confirmed that this will not need to go to Plan Commission.

Lenz introduced the resolution and said that the information in it was given to him by the Historical Society. Lenz asked if any additional information should be added.

Grimm motioned to approve the resolution in support of preserving the historic structure at 813 North 2nd Street. Crooks seconded.

Lenz said that he believes the prospective owners would consider relocating the structure. There is currently no spot in mind. Crooks said that the lot north of the eye clinic is vacant and would be a good fit. Lenz said that it is a city owned parcel and it may be a possibility.

The motion carried unanimously 4-0.
