### 1) Approval of Minutes

### 2) Clean It up, Wausau - 2019 Events and Drop-off Days

The DPW Supervisor and employees have chosen the dates for 2019. The first Clean It Up, Wausau event will take place with participating from Good New Project and an appliance recycler on Friday and Saturday, April 26 and 27, 2019. Large-Item Drop-Off Days at the Yard Waste Site facility will be on three weekends during the summer and will NOT take appliances or electronics. They are the following 3 summer weekends:

All of these weekends will be from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. DPW would welcome volunteers from the N2N Committee and Neighborhood groups on any of the above weekends as it becomes very busy at the gate and throughout the 2 days. Groeschel will get the word out to the Neighborhood Groups and solicit for volunteers.
