## **PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY COMMITTEE**

Date and Time: Monday, March 20, 2017, 5:15 pm, (Council Chambers)

Others Present: Alfonso, Rayala, Barnes, Czarapata, Bishop, Goede, Mielke, Baeten, Fiorenza, and other interested parties.

### **Consider various license applications**

Rasmussen stated there was one applicant for an Operator's License recommended for denial, John Aumend; it was noted that Mr. Aumend was not present to appeal.

Rasmussen stated there was a new event application submitted for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Block Party by the Wausau River District to celebrate the completion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Streetscape Project from Stewart Avenue to Elm Street. They would like to have a beer garden enclosure for the block party and request permission for The Chatterbox to serve in the beer garden. Elizabeth Field stated this is a one-time event to celebrate the new reconstruction and are requesting that small enclosure for a beer garden for the service of alcohol by The Chatterbox. She indicated there would also be a band for the event. Rasmussen noted this is similar to the annual outdoor party that B&R's has been granted permission for by the committee. She felt since Chatterbox has been licensed in that neighborhood for a very long time, it would be appropriate for this block party.

*NOTE:* The Liquor License Review Subcommittee met before this meeting to consider applications for an available regular Class B Beer & Liquor license. Two applicants were considered: Wanda's Chapter Two, LLC and Downtown Grocery.com LLC. The committee recommended the license be granted to Wanda's Chapter Two, LLC, for the premise at 1810 Merrill Ave, as she was ready to open within a week; whereas Downtown Grocery was still under construction at the former 3<sup>rd</sup> Street location and did not anticipate re-opening there until July.

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to approve or deny licenses as recommended by staff. Motion carried 5-0.

### **Request for preliminary approval of a Class B Beer license for the Steel Hockey Organization**

Rasmussen stated the Park Department was contacted by the Steel Hockey Organization about the potential to bring a semi-professional hockey team to Wausau that would have quite an extensive home event schedule. They intend to apply for a Class B Beer license, but before the commitment comes from the team they are seeking tentative approval of said license for their concessions.

Cpt. Barnes stated he spoke to the general manager who indicated if it is approved he will be moving to Wausau with his family. The conversation revolved around what the City of Wausau's expectation of a liquor license holder is and the type of compliance checks that the Police Department does. He commented their plan, which they use in other communities, exceeds what we would expect, with wrist banding and limiting the amount of alcohol that can be purchased at a particular time. He stated the Police Department has no objection to the license.

Motion by Kellbach, second by Wagner to tentatively approve a Class B Beer license for the Steel Hockey Organization. Motion carried 5-0.

### **Discussion and possible action on First Amendment to Police Department Shooting Range License Agreement**

Rasmussen stated the City Attorney and the Police Department have been working with 3M to update the license agreement for the shooting range. She noted they are constructing a building at the range to replace the old one after selling some surplus.

Motion by Wagner, second by McElhaney to approve the amendment to the agreement. Motion carried 5-0.

### **Discussion and possible action on request for waiver of 8.08.011(c)(1) no more than 2 hives for beekeeping (Angela Uhl)**

Rasmussen stated earlier this year we approved a permit for Angela Uhl for two hives at the Wausau Municipal Airport, which is a remote location with no public access. Ms. Uhl is requesting permission for a third hive because she has found someone to mentor her, who would put one of his hives next to her two to work with her on how to be a beekeeper.

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to approve the waiver of 8.08.011(c)(1) no more than two hives, for Angela Uhl. Motion carried 5-0.

**Operations Report from Fire Department for February 2017**

Czarapata noted there was no sick leave use in the last month despite the flu season. He stated we had a number of fire events of which six or seven that were significant, but doesn't seem to be any kind of trend. The use of wood stoves and cooking were common and indicated they may put a public service program together regarding this.

**Tavern Activities / Compliance Checks / Law Enforcement Activities**

Cpt. Barnes presented the Tavern Report for February 2, 2017 through March 3, 2017. (*See attached*)

Barnes noted the failure to comply with our underage alcohol compliance checks is still high; we had 5 of 11 establishments sell to our underage volunteers, which is not acceptable.

**Consider the complaint and take action on issuing a summons commanding the licensee/Austyn M. Savaske to appear before the committee for a hearing to show cause why the Operator's License issued to her should not be revoked.**

Rasmussen stated this corresponds to the impaired server ordinance in which the city has a right to convene a hearing for the revocation of the Operator's License.

Lt. Todd Baeten explained officers responded to an anonymous complaint on March 1, 2017 after 1:00 a.m., that the bartender was impaired at the Cabaret Bar. The officers made contact with the bartender, Austyn Savaske. She appeared to be impaired and officers requested a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which she refused. He noted a citation was subsequently issued to her.

Alfonson pointed out the complaint was filed not just because she refused the PBT, but also because of the alleged violation of the sober server ordinance, in that she appeared to be highly intoxicated.

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to issue a summons and convene a hearing regarding the revocation or suspension of the Operator License for Austyn Savaske. Motion carried 5-0.

**HEARING: Ya M. Yang, owner, appeal of dangerous animal designation declaration - Hunter**

Rasmussen asked the City Clerk to swear in all the witnesses at once; Ya M. Yang, his daughter, and Ashlee Bishop were sworn in. Rasmussen explained the procedure for the informal review hearing.

Ya Yang testified to the two incidents, noting the actual owner of the dog is his daughter who has been away at school in Madison. He explained the 4 year old child was playing under the table with the dog at a family gathering and he felt the child was bothering the dog, provoking it. Alfonso and committee members questioned Mr. Yang.

Humane Officer Ashlee Bishop testified to her visit and observations of the dog, as well as comments made by the veterinarian that it may bite again. The owner, Yang's daughter addressed the committee regarding her dog. Discussion took place regarding provocation.

**Closed Session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of considering the following: Deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before the governmental body**

Motion by Wagner, second by Kellbach to convene in closed session to deliberate. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Peckham, McElhaney, Wagner, Kellbach, and Rasmussen. Noes: 0. Motion carried 5-0.

**Reconvened in Open Session, announce results of deliberations on appeal of dangerous animal declaration.**

Rasmussen read the findings of fact and conclusions of law stating they determined that the dog was provoked in the incidents and does not constitute a dangerous animal as defined in WMC 8.08.200(b). Hunter is not declared a dangerous animal and the pet owner is not obligated to comply with the restrictions for a dangerous animal.

**HEARING: Rent Abatement: Ashlee Miller concerning 316 1/2 Prospect Avenue**

Rasmussen asked the City Clerk to swear in the witnesses: Ashlee Miller, Rick Geier, Zandra, and Rich Grefe were sworn in. Rasmussen explained the procedure for the hearing.

Ashlee Miller, tenant, testified to the conditions of the property that she has been living with, most notably the leaking ceiling that has not been fixed.

Rick Geier, property owner/landlord, testified he anticipated her living there temporarily and that his attorney and contractor advised him not to fix the ceiling until Miller moves out. He indicated he issued her a 28 day notice to vacate on March 2, 2017. Mr. Geier's girlfriend Zandra and first floor tenant, commented on his behalf.

Rich Grefe, property inspector, testified to the violations in the apartment following his inspection: missing plaster in kitchen ceiling; no smoke alarms or CO detectors; and leaking ceiling in bedroom. He noted the smoke and CO detectors have since been installed. The ceiling is not fixed and appears to be getting worse and becoming a safety issue near the light fixtures. Questions followed by Alfonso and committee members.

**Closed Session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of considering the following: Deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before the governmental body.**

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to convene in closed session to deliberate. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Peckham, McElhaney, Wagner, Kellbach, and Rasmussen. Noes: 0. Motion carried 5-0.

**Reconvened in Open Session, announce results of deliberations on Hearing on Rent Abatement Application**

Rasmussen read the finding of fact and conclusions of law stating of the 8 housing code violations of which 5 were rent-impairing violations. Certain items were not rent abate-able in the letter and only #6 was abate-able. The committee ordered the tenant's rent to be abated from January 23, 2017 through and including, Monday, March 20, 2017 for a period of 56 days at a rate of 10%, for a total \$93.00. Further, the committee orders tenant's rent to be abated from Monday, March 20, 2015 at a rent of 10% for each day until correction of the rent impairing violation occurs. The landlord is ordered to pay the \$25 filing fee for this action.

*10 minute recess.*

**HEARING: Rent Abatement: Susan Davis concerning 117 Eau Claire Boulevard**

Rasmussen explained the procedure for the hearing and asked the City Clerk to swear in the witnesses: Susan Davis, Navi Dowty, and Rich Grefe were sworn in.

Susan Davis, tenant, described the conditions of the home that she and her husband have been living with including: faulty light fixtures/fans causing shocks; leaking roof; fallen kitchen ceiling tiles; and basement mold. She noted some light fixtures and the kitchen ceiling have since been corrected, but the roof replacement and mold in the basement have not.

Rich Grefe, property inspector, testified to his inspection of the property confirming eight housing code violations. Alfonso and committee followed up with questions.

Navi Dowty, property owner, clarified that he did not represent Easy Living Management. He explained he owns the LLC that owns this building and Easy Living Management manages it because he lives in Illinois. He stated he got bids and hired a contractor to replace the roof within a week of finding out about the issue and the contractor told him it was all done. He stated he would get the contractor to finish the job and did not object to the tenant getting some rent abatement. Discussion took place regarding his address and his contact information.

**Closed Session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of considering the following: Deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before the governmental body.**

Motion by Wagner, second by the McElhaney to convene into closed session. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Peckham, McElhaney, Wagner, Kellbach, and Rasmussen. Noes: 0. Motion carried 5-0.

**Reconvened in Open Session, announce results of deliberations on Hearing on Rent Abatement Application**

Rasmussen read the finding of fact and conclusions of law stating the committee found that six of the eight violations are rent impairing. Violation 10A, cellar light – 5%; 10B, cellar light – 5%; 10C – upper bedroom light – 5%; 10D, upper bedroom light – 5%; 10E, defective roof – 50%; 10F, mold and dampness in basement – 25%. Tenant's rent to be abated from December 16, 2016 through and including Friday, March 17, 2017, which constitutes a period of 91 days at a rate of \$31.67 for a total of \$2,882. Further the committee orders the tenants rent

be abated from Saturday March 18, 2017 at a rate of 80% for each every day until correction of the rent impairing violation. The landlord is ordered to pay the \$25 filing fee for this action.

### **Minutes of the previous meeting(s) (2/20/17)**

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to approve the minutes of a previous meeting. (2/20/2017). Motion carried 4-0.

### **Consider various license applications**

Rasmussen stated there was one supplemental request for the Ginseng Festival to include in their event application the additional closure of Third Street from Washington Street to Jefferson Street.

Motion by Wagner, second by Peckham to approve or deny licenses as recommended by staff. Motion carried 4-0.

### **Request by Roc's Place, 810 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. for an outdoor wedding party, Saturday, May 20, 2017 (Timothy Nawrocki).**

Roc's Place submitted a request to hold an outdoor wedding party on Saturday, May 20, 2017. Jennifer, representing Roc's place addressed the committee and answered a few questions. Kujawa spoke to Jennifer with concerns of the tent issue. Jennifer explained that the tent will be open on all sides with a fence placed all around the tent area. Kujawa requested that Jennifer work with the City of Wausau fire marshal to ensure the tent and the fencing are compliant with any required regulations.

Rasmussen noted they have a plan in place for serving during the event; alcohol will only be sold inside the bar and guests will be wrist banded to make sure IDs are checked.

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach to approve the outdoor wedding party at Roc's Place. Motion carried 4-0.

### **Request for outdoor bands at Athletic Park prior to games for 2017 and a special event – All Star Game & Home Run Derby, July 18, 2017. (Wausau Woodchucks).**

Rasmussen mentioned that for the Home Run Derby there may be a chance that fly balls may be hit out to Third Street. Wausau Woodchucks had previously requested that there is no parking on both sides of Third Street and it to be blocked off to thru traffic. There will be signage for no parking from Wausau Avenue to Hurd parking lot. There still may be a street closure on Third Street, however, this hasn't yet been confirmed as necessary. It was requested that the Parks Department and the Department of Public Works contact the appropriate staff at Wausau Woodchucks to work out any parking issues.

Motion by Packham, second by Kellbach to approve outdoor bands and a special event. Motion carried 4-0.

### **Consider approval of Emergency Management Services Agreement between the City of Wausau and Marathon County**

Rasmussen indicated Tara Alfonso has been working with Phil Rentmeester on the terms of this agreement to both parties satisfaction.

Motion by Wagner, second by Peckham to approve the Emergency Management Services Agreement with Marathon County. Motion carried 4-0.

### **Operations Report from Fire Department for February 2017**

Report was placed on file.

### **Tavern Activities / Compliance Checks / Law Enforcement Activities**

Report was placed on file. March 2, 2017 through April 4, 2017. (See attached)

**Revocation/Suspension Hearing: Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 125.12: alleging certain violations of Wausau Municipal Code Section 5.64.034 adopted pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 125.10. Consider revocation or suspension of the Operator's License of Austyn M. Savaske**

Rasmussen stated this corresponds to the impaired server ordinance in which the city has a right to convene a hearing for the suspension or revocation of the Operator's License. Prior to the hearing Savaske spoke with both Alfonso and Baeton and she was agreeable to admitting the allegations of the complaint to be true. The police department would like to proceed with the hearing. Rasmussen wanted to proceed with the hearing so that Savaske has due process and to be fair and treating all of the hearing participants the same.

The City Clerk swore in all those that were giving testimony: Austyn Savaske, Officer Ben Price, and Officer Mallori Piotrowki.

It was noted on the record that Savaske was not represented by counsel and was not required to testify on this matter. In no way was this to be assumed as her not defending herself.

Lt. Todd Baeton explained officers responded to an anonymous complaint on March 1, 2017 after 1:00 a.m., that the bartender was impaired at the Cabaret Bar. The summons and complaint were served to Savaske on April 6, 2017.

Both officers came forth and gave testimony; based on their training and experience found Savaske to have been intoxicated while working as a server the evening of March 1, 2017 (i.e. slurring her words, swaying back and forth, and strong odor of alcohol). Five paper documents and one body cam video (exhibit #6) were placed on file on behalf of the city as exhibits.

**Closed Session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a),(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes:**

- a. **Deliberation concerning a case which was the subject for any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body; and**
- b. **Considering licensing of any person licensed by a board or commission or the investigation of charges against such person, and the taking of formal action on any such matter; proved that the person licensed is given actual notice of the evidentiary hearing which may be held prior to final action being taken and of any meeting at which final action may be taken for the purpose of deliberating on the revocation or suspension of the Operator's License for Austyn M. Savaske**

Motion by Peckham, second by Kellbach. Roll call vote: Peckham – yes, Kellbach – yes, Wagner – yes, Rasmussen – yes. Motion passed 4-0. Moved into closed session at 6:30 pm.

**Reconvened in Open Session for the purpose of making a determination on the revocation or suspension of the Operator's License for Austyn M. Savaske.**

Motion by Wagner, second by Peckham to reconvene into open session by unanimous vote at 6:55 pm.

Rasmussen read into the record the Findings of Fact in regard to the hearing. The committee agreed unanimously to revoke Savaske's operator's license. If passed, the revocation will commence upon the publication of Common Council meeting action on May 9, 2017.

At this meeting the Committee will be expecting dialogue from you as the agent of M&R Station. Please call my office at 715.261.6620 to confirm your planned attendance. Lastly, know that continued violations could result in non-renewal, suspension or revocation of your license.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS AT TAVERNS TO WHICH POLICE WERE DISPATCHED.**

**M & R Station, 818 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue**

- (1) *Event #170021085, 02/19/17 at 9:17 PM:* A complainant that refused to identify themselves claimed that there was an underage woman at the bar drinking. Officers responded and were unable to locate anyone matching the description provided, and the patrons that were there appeared to be of legal drinking age.
- (2) *Event #170022773, 02/23/17 at 9:46 PM:* A cab driver in the parking lot called to report that there was a woman beating on the reporting person's car. The offending woman left and the complainant stated everything was fine. The caller said he would go inside and talk to the owner and that the Police were no longer needed. No Law Enforcement responded to this call.
- (3) *Case #17-2171, 02/23/17 at 6:15 AM:* Officers were called to respond to a residence in the 700 block of S. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, in reference to a suspicious death. It was learned that the decedent had been at M & R Station the previous night, and had been so highly intoxicated that she had lost consciousness in the bar. There was no call to emergency services to assist the woman at the time. The bar owner and two other people carried the woman to her residence, where they turned her over to her husband. Her husband went back to sleep and discovered her dead in the morning. This incident is still being investigated, including review of the surveillance footage from the bar. Once the investigation is complete, a determination will be made regarding the possible assessment of Demerit Points against the bar. The decedent was also employed as a bartender with the bar, however was not on duty the previous night.

*Excerpt from City of Wausau Municipal Code Chapter 5.64:*

(1) The Public Health and Safety Committee shall call before it for purposes of a revocation or suspension hearing all licensees who have accumulated 100 points in a twelve-month period as a result of court imposed convictions or who have had referred to it reports from the City Attorney which, if believed, would result in 100 demerit points in twelve (12) months.

(A) Formal expression of concern. In those instances in which a licensee has accumulated less than 100 demerit points as determined by the City Attorney, and additional violations on one date would result in the accumulation of at least 100 points but not more than 200 points, the Public Health and Safety Committee shall call before it the licensee for purposes of a formal expression of concern. If the licensee appears, no discussion of the alleged facts underlying the assessment of demerit points shall be permitted unless the licensee requests such discussion but only if the licensee is advised that any statements made by the licensee and/or her/his representatives regarding the alleged facts may be considered by the Public Health and Safety Committee in any subsequent suspension/revocation hearing which may result from the alleged violations which are the subject of the formal expression of concern. If the licensee fails to appear after service of the notice to appear, the matter shall be scheduled for a suspension/revocation hearing. Service of the notice to appear shall be by first class mail sent to the agent, if the licensee is a corporation or a limited liability company, to the licensee if an individual, or to any partner if the licensee is a partnership. If the notice is returned by the Post Office as undeliverable, the notice may be left with any employee found on the licensed establishment at least 24 hours before the date and time of the scheduled appearance before the Public Health and Safety Committee. A formal expression of concern in lieu of the assessment of demerit points may only occur once within a one-year period.



(Previously Baker Street Retreat) Officers conducted a bar check on Saturday, April 15, 2017, at approximately 10:28 PM. Bartender Katelin Sandrini stated that she thought she had a valid operator's license, but since they had just moved, she didn't know where the owner had placed it. In-house records check showed her to have an expired operator's license (06/30/16). Since there was no proof of a valid license, the owner was contacted and recommended that the bar be closed for the night. No citation was issued, but **Demerit Points (50)** assessed.

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**NOTABLE INCIDENTS AT TAVERNS TO WHICH POLICE WERE DISPATCHED.**

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**Cop Shoppe Pub, 701 Washington Street**

- (1) *Case #17004635, 04/27/17 at 11:48 PM:* A **bar employee** called to request medical assistance after a patron fell off of his bar stool. The fall injured and cut his head, causing it to bleed profusely. Officers responded along with an ambulance. The male was intoxicated and refused to remain on scene for medical treatment. The male got into his car and despite Officers' attempts to keep him from leaving the parking lot, he left the lot and a pursuit was begun. The male was eventually taken into custody after several PIT maneuvers were utilized to stop him.

**El Jalapenos, 300 Washington Street #100**

- (1) *Event #170040794, 04/11/17 at 2:27 PM:* A woman called Dispatch reporting that there were two males in the upper bar area that had been running from the Police. One had a bloody face, and the other had no shoes on. Officers responded and made contact with the two men. They had just been released from Jail and were having a soda while waiting for their ride to get there. The two had been involved in a crash on STH 29 at about 2:30 AM, and had run from the scene. They were caught and taken to Jail. The "bloody face" was due to injuries sustained in the crash. They were released after Officers identified who the males were.
- (2) *Event #170048506, 04/30/17 at 12:56 AM:* An Officer conducted a field interview stop because she saw a patron outside with a drink. It was determined the drink was water, and the woman was released with no law enforcement action.



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**Glass Hat Bar, 1203 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street**

- (1) *Event #170042680, 04/16/17 at 2:18 AM:* A **bar employee** flagged down an Officer to report a male that had previously been banned from the bar was on the premises and was refusing. The male said he was banned because his ex-girlfriend was dating a bouncer and got him banned. He willingly left the property and no Law Enforcement action was necessary.
- (2) *Event #170048102, 04/29/17 at 12:42 AM:* A **bar employee** called to report that three black males came into the bar. One of them stuck another patron in the bar and left in a red car. The suspect had threatened to come back with a gun. The struck person also left prior to Officers' arrival. Contact was made with the bar employee that called, who said he only called due to the gun threat. Officers checked again at bar time, and it was related that they had no other problems.

**Hiawatha Restaurant and Lounge, 713 Grant Street**

- (1) *Event #170043534, 04/18/17 at 1:17 AM:* Officers stopped by after closing because the female bartender was concerned about a male that had been asked to leave earlier in the night. The male looked younger, would not show ID and did not give his name. Officer escorted the worker to her car.

**Loppnow's Bar, 1502 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street**

- (1) *Event #170042672, on 04/16/17 at 2:01 AM:* Officers made contact with a male outside the tavern. The male was emotional, and was upset that someone in the bar called him racist. He was not so upset that he was willing to stop drinking and go home, so he went back into the bar.
- (2) *Case #17-4154, 04/17/17 at 9:07 AM:* Officers responded to a panic alarm at the business. The owner was present and said he accidentally hit it while it was in his pocket.

**Malarkey's, 412 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street**

- (1) *Case #17-4423, 04/18/17 at 9:15PM:* Officers took a complaint regarding the defrauding of a fare from a cab ride. The suspect walked into Malarkey's, but went out the back door and over to the Landmark. A suspect was developed that night, but he was not located. About five days later, the male was located as a passenger of another traffic stop and taken into custody for fraud on a taxi cab and probation violation. While being transported to the Jail, the male urinated and spit in the back of the squad.



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**Pollock Inn, 1206 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street**

- (1) *Event #170045205, 04/22/17 at 1:22 AM:* A woman flagged down an Officer to report that her boyfriend had been assaulted (punched in the face). The victim explained that there had been a “rap show” at the bar, and one of the acts he had paid to see did not perform at the show. The victim started chanting the rapper’s name, at which point an unknown white male came up and punched him in the face. The victim stated he didn’t know the suspect, and had sustained no injury, and declined to pursue charges. His girlfriend attempted to talk him into it, but failed. The Officer left the victim with a business card, should he have had a change of heart. A witness took a photo of the suspect, and a plate number was obtained from a suspect vehicle.

**Wausau on the Water (WOW), 1300 N. River Drive**

- (1) *Event #170045502, 04/22/17 at 5:43 PM:* An **employee** called to report that there was a vehicle with eight adults parked in the lot at the south end of the property for the Family Center. They were drinking out of the vehicle. The people had requested to use the restrooms in the Family Center. The Officer that responded and advised the employee that should would have been within her rights to allow only paying customers to use their facility. A conversation was also had as to whether or not they could drink where they had been parked. The Officer took that stance that he thought it was a park, which would allow people to be drinking there. The employee asked if their customers could then take their alcoholic beverages from their patio or “to go” in order to take them to the park. She was advised by the Officer to contact the City to see if that would be allowed.

*NOTE: The compilation of this report is the first I have heard of this issue. It is my opinion that the Officer was misinformed, in that the Riverwalk is not a dedicated park, but rather a connecting route between parks, and therefore does NOT have the same freedoms in regards to open intoxicants as a park would. It would then also stand that WOW customers would not be able to take open intoxicants “to go” and walk around on the Riverwalk veranda with them.*

- (2) *Event #170049583, 05/02/17 at 6:43 PM:* Officers responded to WOW for a welfare check. A refused complainant suspected that a woman that was at the facility with three children was under the influence of drugs. Officers responded, but were unable to locate the woman. They were told by people there that the woman and children had already left, and no one was sure where she had gone.



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**DenMar Bar**, 601 W. Thomas Street

- (1) *Event #170041288, 04/12/17 at 5:06 PM:* An ambulance was requested after an older male patron had fallen and struck his head. No Officers responded to this call. The ambulance transported the male to the hospital. I believe it was a **bartender** that called.
- (2) *Case #17-4179, 04/17/17 at 11:16 PM:* A refused complainant called to report that there was a male drinking at the tavern in violation of his rules of probation. Officers responded and located the male. It was confirmed that it was a probation violation, and the male was taken into custody and taken to jail. This is the second type of this report from this location in as many months.

**Eagle's Club**, 1703 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

- (1) *Case #17-4806, 04/30/17 at 11:36 PM:* Officers responded to the tavern for a burglar alarm. The building was found to be secure, and no key holders responded. An alarm form was completed.

**Roc's Place**, 810 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

- (1) *Event #170038843, 04/07/17 at 12:10 AM:* A **bar employee** called for assistance in removing a patron from the premises. On arrival, Officers located the male outside the bar. He was identified and released. The bar employee simply wanted him removed. No further Law Enforcement action.

**Treu's Tic Toc Club**, 1201 W. Thomas Street

- (1) *Event #170045685 on 04/23/17 at 2:32 AM:* The bartender called to request an escort after closing as she had asked an intoxicated person to leave earlier in the evening. She was provided an escort and was grateful.

**M & R Station**, 818 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

- (1) *Event #170046575, 04/25/17 at 11:12 AM:* A bar employee called to report an abandoned bicycle on the property. An Officer responded and collected it.



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- (2) *Case #17-2171, 02/23/17 at 6:15 AM:* This incident was an investigation of a sudden death, later determined to have been an overdose death. The decedent, had been at M & R Station earlier in the night, and had become unresponsive there. The owner, Rick Gordon, with the assistance of two others, removed the woman and transported her to her residence, where she later died. I am listing this incident now, as the majority of the investigation is complete. It was evident through the investigation that had employees from the bar called an ambulance or police when the decedent had first become unresponsive, the chances of saving her life would have been drastically improved. As a result, although it does not appear that the owner or the others that assisted the owner in the removal of the person from the bar, they had a responsibility to contact emergency services. As a result, I have assessed them **100 Demerit Points**, for failing to summon police (50 Points), with the enhancer that the conduct resulted in bodily harm to any individual/created a substantial risk of death or bodily harm (50 Points).

**101 Pub, 101 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue**

- (1) *Event #170045542, 04/22/17 at 6:58 PM:* The bartender called to request assistance in removing an unruly patron. The patron was reported to have spit on the bar floor and punched another patron in the arm. He refused to leave when asked. Officers arrived and located the male in the tavern and escorted him outside. The male continued to walk, until getting in the front seat of his truck, as if to drive home. The Officers prevented him from driving, and gave him a ride home after checking with the bartender and the patron that had been struck as to whether or not they wanted any other Law Enforcement action taken.

**After Shock Bar and Grill, 1418 Lenard Street**

- (1) *Event #170042594, 04/15/17 at 10:23 PM:* Officers responded to the bar for a standard bar check. The bartender on duty was alone, and had only an expired operator's license. She called the owner, who advised to close the bar for the night. No citation was issued, however I assessed the bar **50 Demerit Points** for no licensed bartender.

**Callon Street Pub, 209 Callon Street**

- (1) *Event #170043925, 04/19/17 at 2:28 AM:* Officers called out at the tavern with a male that was loitering near the business. No other information was noted in the call.

**Campus Pub, 1110 W. Campus Drive**

- (1) *Event #170045700, 04/23/17 at 3:05 AM:* Officers responded to a call of a two vehicle crash that occurred in the parking lot. When they got there, there was no one around and nothing that would have indicated that a crash took place. No further action was taken.



Wausau Police Department

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**Cruisin1724**, 1724 Merrill Avenue

- (1) *Event #170042207, 04/14/17 at 11:12 PM:* An Officer was driving by the bar when he observed a patron outside in front of the bar, standing next to a vehicle appearing to relieve himself. By the time the Officer came around the building, the male was gone. Contact was made with the bartender to keep an eye on the activity on their property.

**Mountain Lanes/Jump On It**, 1401 Elm Street

- (1) *Case #17-3791, 04/09/17 at 2:13 AM:* Officers observed a male urinating in the parking lot. The male was issued a citation (DC). While Officers were still there, at about 2:29 AM, the staff pushed out about 200 patrons from into the lot and locked the doors. Officers were forced to mitigate the crowd to prevent problems. Several people in the crowd were raising their arms saying, "Hands up! Don't Shoot!" There were others that were shouting, "Oink, Oink." Officers on scene spoke with the owner to advise her that they are responsible for the parking lot activity as well, and that they should not get everyone out at the last minute.
- (2) *Event #170044745, 04/21/17 at 5:02 AM:* A caller that refused to be identified reported that there was a pickup truck that was half in the parking lot and half over the sidewalk and onto Elm Street. Officers responded and found the truck as reported, hanging over the ledge and unoccupied. The registered owner was contacted, and he admitted that the owners had called him about the truck, and he had planned to get it later in the morning. Officers explained that it was a traffic hazard for Elm Street, and needed to be moved. The owner had the keys, but said he hadn't driven it and didn't know how it got to be in the location it was found in. He later responded to the scene and allowed a tow truck to remove the vehicle.
- (3) *Case #17-4440, 04/23/17 at 2:29 PM:* Officers responded to the business for a panic alarm. On arrival, it was learned that an employee had set something on the panic alarm, not knowing that it was there. A false alarm form was completed.

They were advised that since they entered into some sort of agreement with the subject, it was a civil matter and they could sue the subject for the amount of the bill (\$146.00).

(2) *Event #170046432, 04/25/17 at 12:32 AM:* Officers responded to a call from the owner regarding two males that refused to leave the property. Officers responded and made contact with the males. It turns out that a girlfriend of one of the males was working as a dancer, but he didn't watch her. She got mad and threw a glass at him, hitting him in the face. When the bar staff learned that the male was a boyfriend of a dancer, they advised him that it was bar policy that they did not allow boyfriends in the bar while their girlfriend was working. The male struck with the glass did not want to pursue any charges, but considered later "legal action" against the bar. All the patrons involved left the tavern.

## **ALCOHOL BEVERAGE DEMERIT POINTS ASSESSED**

- **After Shock Bar and Grill** was assessed **50 Demerit Points** for being open without a licensed operator or owner on the premises.
- **M & R Station** was assessed **100 Demerit Points** for failure to notify police, with the enhancer that the conduct resulted in bodily harm to any person/created a substantial risk of death or great bodily harm.

**ORDINANCE OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Creating Section 8.08.012 Keeping of Chickens

The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 8.08.012 Keeping of Chickens, is hereby created to read as follows:

8.08.012 Keeping of Chickens.

- (a) Permit Required. No person shall keep chickens or establish or maintain any henhouse upon any premises in the city without obtaining a valid permit issued by the city clerk.
- (1) A permit shall be valid for a period of one-year from July 1 through June 30, and may be renewed annually.
  - (2) The permit process requires submission of a completed application accompanied with a fee as provided in section 3.40.010(a) and shall include proof of registration with the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection in accordance with Wis. Stat. §95.51.
  - (3) A late fee of two times the application fee along with the application fee as provided in section 3.40.010(a) shall be collected from every owner or keeper of chickens if the owner or keeper fails to obtain a license prior to July 1 of each year, or fails to obtain a license prior to acquiring the chickens.
  - (4) Prior to issuance of a permit, the applicant shall submit to an inspection and demonstrate that all requirements of subsection (b) are met.
  - (5) The holder of a valid permit may keep chickens accordance with this section notwithstanding the prohibitions in section 8.08.010(a) of this Code.
- (b) Standards. A permit authorizes the keeping of chickens on a premises, provided the following requirements are met:

- (1) No more than four (4) hens or pullets are allowed on a premises.
- (2) Roosters are prohibited.
- (3) Chickens may only be kept at a residential zoning lot designated as R-1 or R-2 "Single Family Residence District," or upon a lot designated as R-3 "Two Family Residence District." A permit shall be issued only to the primary owner(s) of record. The property owner shall reside on the premises regulated by the permit.
- (4) No slaughter of chickens may occur on the premises or within the City other than at a licensed meat processing facility.
- (5) Chickens may only be kept in a chicken coop or an attached and contiguous run. Between sunrise and sunset, chickens may be allowed outside of the coop into the run. Chickens must be secured within the coop between sunset and sunrise.
- (6) The chicken coop or run shall only be located within the rear yard of the premises. A chicken coop and run must be located no closer than ten (10) feet to any property line and no closer than twenty-five (25) feet to any principal residential structure on an adjacent lot.
- (7) Chicken coops and attached and contiguous runs shall be large enough to provide at least 3 square feet per chicken and cannot exceed a maximum of 24 square feet in size.
- (8) Chicken coops and runs shall be constructed in a workmanlike manner, be moisture-resistant and either raised up off the ground or placed on a hard surface such as concrete, patio block or gravel. Chicken coops and runs must be secure and impermeable to rodents, wild birds and predators, including dogs and cats and must be constructed or modified in a fashion to provide a humane environment for the chickens, include adequate ventilation, adequate sun, adequate shade and adequate protection from adverse weather.
- (9) Commercial activity related to the keeping of chickens is prohibited, including fertilizer production and the sale of eggs.
- (10) All food supplies maintained for the chickens must be kept in a secure and rodent-proof container.
- (11) All waste generated by the chickens, operation of the coop and run shall be disposed of in a sanitary manner or composted according to best practices.
- (12) The care and handling of chickens shall comply with other provisions of chapter 8 of this Code, including but not limited to §8.08.020, mistreating of animals, and §8.08.120 providing proper food and drink.

(c) Permit revocation. A permit shall be subject to revocation upon failure to comply with any provisions of this section. Once a permit is revoked, a permit shall not be reissued.

(d) Upon written request, the Public Health & Safety Committee may consider waiver of any requirement specified in this section on a case by case basis upon a satisfactory showing that such requirement is not necessary for the protection and safety of the public, adjoining property owners, and the surrounding neighborhood in such case.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of publication.

Section 1. That Section 8.08.125 Restrictions on animals other than dogs and cats, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.08.125 Restrictions on animals other than dogs and cats. (a) Number. No person shall keep more than ~~three~~ four (4) domestic animals, to include rabbits, gerbils, hamsters, guinea pigs, rats or other similar pets, more than two months old on any premises at any place or in any one residence located within the city limits, except in a B-3 zone or in an area zoned for agricultural use.

(b) Location and Restraint Required. It is unlawful for any person to keep or maintain any yard establishment for the housing of small animals, except dogs and cats, closer than ~~one hundred~~ twenty five (25) feet to any principal residential structure on an adjacent lot ~~the nearest portion of any building occupied by or in anywise used by human beings, other than the dwelling occupied by the owner or keeper of the animals,~~ or closer than ~~twenty-five~~ ten (10) feet to the property line of the lot on which such animals are kept ~~for sale within a bona fide produce market, commission house or store for purposes of trade and while so kept are confined in small coops, boxes or cages, or where such animals are kept for purposes of research in a laboratory.~~ Animals so kept or maintained shall be enclosed, with screening or other similar material, on all sides and shall not be allowed to run or fly at large except for homing pigeons.

Section 2. That Section 8.08.190 Animals not to run at large, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.08.270 Animals not to run at large.

....

(b) Under to provisions of this section, the animal shall be considered as running at large when it is not on the premises of its owner (or in the case of chickens confined as provided in section 8.01.012(b)), unless it is on a leash no more than six feet in length, . .

Section 3. That Section 8.08.270 Penalty, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.08.190 Penalty.

(d) Any person who violates section 8.08.012 shall be subject to a penalty of \$100.00 plus costs.
