Minutes from the May 2, 2016 Meeting

1. Officer Nate wasn't able to attend our meeting but he sent another officer to distribute the Briefing Sheet and share some additional information with our group. The Wausau Police Department is changing the robo-call provider from Code Red to Nixel.
2. Kevin and Jennifer Hutchhausen spoke to our group about their business ventures: Re/Max Excel Realty and Wausau Pickers.
 - Jennifer and Kevin shared with us that there are currently fewer than 700 real estate listings in Wausau and they are selling quickly.
 - Wausau Pickers opened about 17 months ago and is open each Friday and the first Saturday of each month. Wholesalers from a variety of other cities (such as Minneapolis) come to the flea market to shop. The food truck event they had last summer was so successful they will now be in the parking lot the third Thursday of each month during the summer. There is also usually a kettle corn vendor in the parking lot each week. Wausau Pickers does some purchasing and accepts consignment items as well (there is a 30% fee). There are 50 vendor spots that can be rented (\$35 flat fee for a 10' X 10" spot).
3. The group discussed all the changes happening at the Wausau Center. Sears leaving could accelerate the revitalization of the facility. The goal is for the Wausau Center to become a destination, not just a mall. In order for that to happen, Wausau Center must appeal to multiple generations and audiences. Possible changes, including adding a theater, were discussed.
