Minutes from the March 6, 2017 Meeting

Officer Max LaPorte and Officer Bertram spoke to our group on multiple topics:

- Officer LaPorte and Officer Nate Stetzer are both part of the Community Resource Unit and are also the joint neighborhood group contacts
- Wausau Police Department is no longer sending out robo-calls; they can't target the calling areas narrowly enough for this method to be effective
- robo-calls have been replaced by NIXLE; you can register through the NIXLE website (<http://www.nixle.com/>) or text 888777 and "WausauPD" in the message
- our neighborhood includes 2 City sectors; Sector B is from Thomas Street north to Bridge street; Sector C is from Thomas Street south to the Schofield City line

Several telephone scams were discussed:

- a resident reported a phone call/recording requesting personal information and a request to send a money order to an apartment address
- several other telephone scams were reported and discussed
- if contacted by telephone to donate, it is always suggested that you request the organization mail you the information so you can decide whether or not you wish to contribute

A question was asked regarding Marathon County fundraising. The County still raises funds through the telephone sale of trash bags. The Wausau Police Department no longer does telephone fund raising.

The possibility of a painting project (paint, brushes and/or rollers to be furnished by Sherwin Williams) was discussed. One of our residents requested everyone look around for a house or garage in our neighborhood that could use painting and bring a list of them to the next meeting.

A representative from the Forest Park Neighborhood group was at our meeting and shared that their neighborhood group has 3 volunteers who contact people before meetings as an alternative to the robo-calls.
