### Minutes from the May 1, 2017 Meeting

The group discussed our painting project (suggestions are a single-story house, garage, shed, fence, porch, and/or foundation). While preference would be given to owner-occupied properties, rental properties are included. Sherwin Williams will furnish the paint; the date would be weather (and volunteer) dependent. Contact Anne and/or Romey with your suggestions.

Tammy Stratz (Community Development) talked about the Tot Lot and the flags/banners. Development of the Tot Lot (on the northeast corner of Single and Prospect) will begin on May 8<sup>th</sup> with completion in 3-5 weeks (*see the picture on the bottom of the newsletter*). A dedication will be held upon completion. Neighborhood flags are still in process (due to a delay in obtaining the appropriate material) but the frames to hold them are installed.

Drones were discussed. Marathon County has them for use in specific circumstances (search and rescue, etc.) but the City of Wausau does not have any.

The main topics on the Briefing Sheet were home security (be sure and lock your vehicles) and call volume (currently typical for our area but the usual Summer increase is expected).

We also talked about how the Wausau Police Department handles contact with Special Needs individuals, including those with mental health issues. The Department has 2 specialists on staff to assist with those contacts.
