Minutes from the August 7, 2017 Meeting

1. Residents shared the following concerns/issues:
 - A small child was found wandering on Prospect Avenue early one morning; the child was found by the Police and returned to his home.
 - A concrete statue, gazing ball and outdoor furniture were stolen in the 300 and 400 blocks of Prospect.
 - Two cars were entered on Henrietta. Always lock your car doors, especially if they're parked outside. Motion detectors on the side of your garage or home help deter crime.
 - A skunk was seen on Arthur Street.
 - Trees are overhanging the sidewalk on Prospect near the overpass.
2. A minimum of 2 red mesh benches for the Tot Lot will be purchased and installed.
3. The banners for our neighborhood are complete! The specific locations for them are being finalized but probably be on the boundary streets of Townline, Forest, and Grand Avenue.
4. Contact Anne if you know someone who needs a smoke detector. Be sure and check your carbon monoxide detectors (replace the batteries, or the entire unit, as needed).
5. The Historical Society hosts a free vintage board game night the 4th Friday of each month from 7:00 – 10:00 PM at the Woodson History Center (410 McIndoe Street). They provide free board games and popcorn or you can bring your own games.
6. Current Briefing Sheet report:
 - A Community Thank You Event will be held Tuesday, August 29, 11:30 AM – 1:30 PM on the 400 Block.
 - Residents can report incidents (car break-ins and/or thefts, etc.) on-line. This will assist the Police Department in pinpointing “problem” areas and/or patterns.
 - Traffic stops have been increased to reduce speeding and/or other traffic infractions.
