Minutes from the February 5, 2018 Meeting

1. Officer Nick Stetzer brought his therapy dog, Badge, to our meeting.
  - Badge is a 3-year-old flat-coated retriever and is Officer Stetzer's personal pet. Badge attended a 6-week training course in order to become a certified therapy dog. A dog with good social skills is more important than a specific breed type (golden retrievers are the most commonly used therapy dog breed).
  - A therapy dog in the school system was suggested by Officer Stetzer and has been actively supported by the Wausau Police Department by way of this pilot program. Officer Stetzer is aware of only other one other therapy dog in the state.
  - Badge assists Officer Stetzer in his duties as the Wausau East High School Resource Officer and began working as a therapy dog in October, 2017. Badge helps students with panic attacks, stress, etc. and works with Special Education students and those with mental health issues. Hopefully Badge will be used to help assault victims beginning this summer. Several other schools in our area have reached out to Officer Stetzer for more information about therapy dogs.
2. Officer Jake Chittum discussed the Briefing Sheet with the group, with an emphasis on animal ordinances this month. Officer Chittum has been with the Wausau Police Department for 5 years and works in the Community Resource Unit. Officers Ross Kramer (a trainee) and Shawn Meyer also attended our meeting and all three officers listened to and addressed concerns expressed by attendees.
3. Romey answered several questions regarding the status of the Wausau Center.
4. Anne advised us of upcoming scheduled speakers.
  - March: a representative from the Wausau Man Of Honor Society (a veterans organization)
  - April: a possible debate between the 2 candidates for District 2 (Romey Wagner and Michael Martens)
  - May: Christian Schock (Director of the Wausau Community Development Department) and possibly Christine Martens (Marathon County Historical Society).
