

Minutes from the December 2, 2018 Meeting

1. Officer Nate Stetzer went over the Briefing Sheet with the group; there were 14 search warrants last month including for pot and meth seizures. Heroin arrests have decreased while meth arrests have increased; cocaine use has increased while huffing has decreased. Most of the meth in our area comes from Minneapolis while heroin and cocaine come from Madison, Milwaukee and Chicago. Nate also talked about Community Oriented Policing; the latest event they were involved in was “Shop With A Cop” (held yesterday).
2. Christine Martens spoke to the group about the Master Gardener Program of Marathon County. Classes for Master Gardener Volunteers will be held on Tuesdays from March 5 – May 21, 2019; total cost for the classes is \$100. Volunteers are required to take continuing education courses and to volunteer to maintain certification. There will be a Garden Visions 2019 Conference on 1/25 and 1/26/19; cost is \$56. The Conference will begin with a slow food dinner on Friday (1/25/19) with Michael Perry as a featured speaker. The Saturday, (1/26/19) session includes speakers on “Building an Outdoor Room” and “Jumping Worms”.
3. Everyone who attended the meeting enjoyed pizza and lots of other goodies. Thank you to Anne for the pizza and to everyone who brought something to share—whether it was food or their presence.
