Here’s a few interesting facts about the city’s snow plow operation: There are 509 miles of street and 9 miles of sidewalk that are maintained by the Department of Public Works crews. It can take 8-9 hours to plow the routes during an average snow storm of 6 inches and during the 2018 season the average cost of removal was \$42,600 per storm. DPW crews are efficient and highly trained, and are able to do all this with a staff half the size of what it was 30 years ago. Please remember if you see a truck working on the city streets or highways, to give them plenty of room to complete their job.
