Minutes from the April 6, 2020 Meeting

No minutes since the meeting was cancelled due to COVID-19 concerns and Safer at Home guidelines. Instead, I'd like to take this opportunity to share some information.

Election Information

(Information provided by the Wausau City Clerk)

- In-Person early voting for the May 12th Special Election will be offered at City Hall from 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM the weeks of April 27 – May 1 and May 4 – May 8. Voter registration can also be completed during this time.
- Mail absentee ballot requests must be made in writing. Requests can be made online (on the Wausau City website under “Departments”, “Clerk” “Elections”) or by completing an application (a copy with instructions for completing it are included with this newsletter). The last day for requesting absentee ballots is the Thursday prior to Election Day (May 7 in this case). Ballots must be returned to the City Clerk in time so it can be delivered to the polling place no later than 8:00 PM on Election Day (May 12).
- The City is recruiting poll workers for the fall elections. This is a fantastic way to take part in the democratic process and to socialize with the community. The City Clerk and her staff provide training plus lunch and dinner on election day. Poll workers are not volunteers, they are paid an hourly wage. Applications are available online or people can also complete an application at their polling location on election day.

Clean It Up, Wausau

Wausau residents (proof of residency is required) can properly, and safely, dispose of unwanted items. Items can be dropped off at 105 E. Chellis Street (the east end of E. Chellis Street near the Yard Waste Site). Appliances and electronics can be dropped off (electronics, tires, dehumidifiers,

air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers are accepted for a fee). They are also accepting some medical equipment in working condition (no fees apply) in partnership with the Good News Project. Details can be found in the Wausau Works For You, Spring 2020 newsletter.
