SNOW EMERGENCY

A snow emergency will be in effect from 4:00 p.m. Monday, December 30, 2019 until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 31, 2019.

Vehicles shall not be parked on streets during this time period in order for City crews to plow streets for commuting traffic, maintain bus transportation, insure emergency vehicles can respond and allow for city crews to remove snow as necessary. Keeping parked vehicles off of the streets reduces the risk of accidents with snow plow equipment during heavy snow and low visibility situations. ***Vehicles parked on City streets during a snow emergency will be ticketed and the forfeiture is \$100.***

Drivers should use extreme caution on snow-covered streets and during low visibility and heavy snowfall times. Please slow down and stay clear of snow plows. Thank you for your compliance with this snow emergency.
