



SNOW EMERGENCY

A snow emergency will be in effect from **9:00 p.m. Sunday February 9, 2020 until 10:00 a.m. on Monday February 10, 2020**. Vehicles shall not be parked on streets during this time period in order for City crews to plow and remove snow from streets for commuting traffic, maintaining bus transportation, and assuring emergency vehicles can respond. ***Vehicles parked on City streets during this time period are subject to being ticketed. The forfeiture for parking on the street during a snow emergency is \$100.*** Keeping parked vehicles off of the streets reduces the risk of accidents with snow plow equipment during heavy snow and low visibility situations.

A reminder to residents of the following to help us keep the roads clear for traffic:

1. Please make sure your garbage and recycling containers are placed behind the curb for pick up
2. Please do not blow or plow snow into the street as this is against City Ordinance

Please drive cautiously on snow-covered streets and during low visibility and heavy snowfall times. Stay clear of snow plows and maintain a minimum distance of 75ft behind so you are out of the driver's blind spots.
