City of Wausau – West Industrial Park Bow Hunter Registration

The City of Wausau has undeveloped property owned by the City of Wausau in the West Industrial Park available for bow hunters to hunt. The bow hunter must first register with the Wausau Police Department and will then be provided a letter of receipt of registration to hunt this property. A map of where those West Industrial Park properties are located is available at the Wausau Police Department's "Bow Hunt" webpage (www.ci.wausau.wi.us/Departments/Police/BowHunt.aspx) or at the Wausau Police Department. There is no limit on the number of bow hunters allowed to register to hunt these properties. This is a privilege provided by the City of Wausau. Hunters are expected to be courteous to each other and not trespass on other business-owned properties.

Along with completing the requested information below, the bow hunter must provide the following:

1. Hunter's Wisconsin DNR Archery Hunting License
2. Photo identification (*as proof of person named on hunting license*)
